FROM FR. MIKE:

"Do not tell the vision to anyone until the Son of Man has been raised from the dead." This seems like an odd way for Jesus to conclude the experience of the Transfiguration, the focus of today's Mass. But what Matthew is really saying is that only in light of Jesus' resurrection can anyone truly understand who Jesus is. Until you know and accept that Christ was raised from dead, no testimony about Jesus nor the Kingdom of God will lead people to faith. I mentioned last week about Bishop Robert Barron's recent podcast on "5 Reasons Catholics Don't Evangelize." (wordonfireshow.com/episode84). Bishop Barron mentions the importance of becoming familiar with the common objections you may encounter against Catholics or Christianity in general. Some examples include, "Why do Catholics worship saints?" (We don't but do ask them for their prayers) and "Why do Catholics try to repeat the sacrifice of Christ on the cross at Mass? (We don't as the Mass brings forward God's love unleashed by the one sacrifice of Jesus' crucifixion). When we engage in apologetics, which is the study of the Catholic rebuttals to these arguments, it does mean we have to do put some effort in better understanding what the Catholic Church teaches. But ultimately what we are really doing is proclaiming in more specific ways the goodness of Christ and his resurrection in our life.

DEL PADRE MIGUEL:

"No le digas a nadie la visión hasta que el Hijo del Hombre haya resucitado de entre los muertos." Esto parece ser una manera extraña para Jesús de concluir la experiencia de la Transfiguración, que es el enfoque de la Misa de hoy. Pero lo que Mateo realmente está diciendo es que sólo con la luz de la resurrección de Jesús puede alguien realmente entender quién es Jesús. Hasta que conozcas y aceptes que Cristo fue resucitado de entre los muertos, ningún testimonio sobre Jesús ni sobre el Reino de Dios puede conducir a la gente a la fe. Mencioné la semana pasada sobre el reciente podcast del obispo Robert Barron sobre "5 razones por las que los católicos no evangelizan" (wordonfireshow.com/episode84). El obispo Barron menciona la importancia de familiarizarse con las objeciones comunes que pueden encontrar contra los católicos o el cristianismo en general. Algunos ejemplos incluyen: "¿Por qué los católicos adoran a los santos?" (No lo hacemos, pero si les pedimos sus oraciones) y "¿Por qué los católicos tratan de repetir el sacrificio de Cristo en la cruz en la misa? (No lo hacemos, la Misa muestra el amor de Dios por nosotros en el sacrificio de la crucifixión de Jesús). Cuando nos dedicamos a la apologética, que es el estudio de las refutaciones católicas a estos argumentos, significa que tenemos que hacer un esfuerzo para entender mejor lo que la Iglesia Católica enseña. Pero en última instancia lo que realmente estamos haciendo es proclamar de manera más específica la bondad de Cristo y su resurrección en nuestra vida.

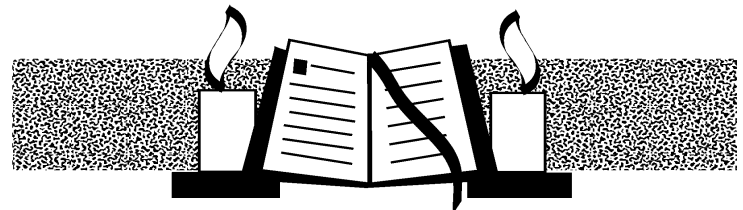
