Parish Events and Happenings

<u>CENTENNIAL CAMPAIGN CLOSING IN ON 645,000!</u> On May 6-7, St. Anthony launched the Centennial Campaign with two goals: (1) Remodel the sanctuary, paint the entire church interior, and clean and seal the wooden ceiling and beams. (2) Initiate an endowment for the long-term financial future of the parish.

Goal: Our campaign goal is \$750,000, with \$450,000 earmarked for physical improvements, and \$300,000 set aside for the endowment.

Progress: As of August 15, we have received 214 gifts and pledges totaling \$598,000! That makes us eligible for the full \$45,000 Hommerding Incentive Fund matching grant offered by the Catholic Development Foundation. Adding the 214 donations to the Hommerding Grant, we now have a grand total of \$643,000 pledged to the campaign. Thank you to all who have contributed and will contribute!

FR. COURTRIGHT'S 25TH ANNIVERSARY MASS Fr. Courtright celebrated 25 years as a priest earlier this year. The community of St. Anthony's plans to commemorate this anniversary by holding a special Mass for Fr. Courtright on Sunday, October 8, at 12:00 PM at St. Mary's Cathedral. A special choir is being put together to sing for this liturgy. Rehearsals will be held Mondays, September 18, 25, and October 2 from 7:00 PM-8:00 PM.
