

## World Youth Day Bio Series

Meet a Pilgrim! In preparation for the first Christmas, Mary and Joseph journeyed from Nazareth to Bethlehem. Today's pilgrims don't have quite the same challenges of such a journey,

but much can be learned by their travels and growth on the way. In next few weeks, we will feature one of our pilgrims as they prepare to make the trip to participate at World Youth Day. This week, we hear from Michael Wilde, a chaperone on the pilgrimage and our Director of Religious Education.

As a chaperone for the St. Anthony's delegation to World Youth Day, I am also very much a pilgrim on this journey and tremendously blessed to have the honor. Although I had the experience of attending WYD in the US, the opportunity to travel abroad with young people in our parish and encourage them as they encounter Christ is exciting and clearly a part of God's providential plan for me.

I have several reasons I am drawn to this journey: My grandmother was from Poland; my mother's good friend (like an aunt to me) was a prisoner in a concentration camp similar to Auschwitz (which we will visit); St. John Paul II (from Poland) was present at the world youth day I attended in Colorado; Pope Francis has declared this the Year of Mercy and this pilgrimage will include a visit to the location where the image and prayer of Divine Mercy were revealed. There are many indicators that this opportunity is not only exciting, but is clearly covered in God's fingerprints.

Finding myself at St. Anthony's with such rich community and journeying alongside these youths assures me that God has still more planned for my future. I am grateful for the efforts of the students, support from their families, and generous prayerful and financial support from St. Anthony's.
