

WORK CREWS ON SITE ~ CENTENNIAL CAMPAIGN BEGINS WRAP UP

The remodeling and painting crew began work in the church on July 10. The onset of work doesn't mean that our Centennial Campaign is complete. It just means we have made sufficient progress to move forward, confident that our campaign goal will be attained even as work is underway.

- **Progress!** In just two months we have 157 donors totaling \$437,606 in gifts and pledges! Thank you!
- Pledge / Give Online. It's easy. To make a gift or pledge on line, go to www.stanthonyfargo.org and click on Giving.
- **Monthly Gift Plans.** The pledge period is *up to* five years. Many families have committed to a monthly donation, but you can make quarterly or annual payments or a one-time donation —whatever suits your circumstances.
- **Flexible Giving Options**. Some people may know *how much* they want to give, but can't make the first payment until next year. That's perfectly fine. Schedule your first payment when it's convenient for you.
- **Leverage Your Gift.** The Catholic Development Foundation has awarded St. Anthony a matching grant. For every dollar given for work on the church, the Foundation will match 10%, up to \$45,000.
