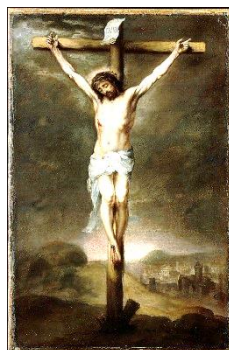

## **A little about St. Anthony – from the desk of Fr. Gross**

Tomorrow, June 13, we celebrate the feast day of our beloved parish patron, St. Anthony of Padua. Although he is now known by the name of a city in Italy, Anthony was born Fernando Martins in Lisbon, Portugal in 1195.

Originally intending to serve as a parish priest, Anthony decided instead to join the Franciscans a year after his ordination. He met a group of friars who settled near Lisbon, and had seen relics of Franciscan martyrs who had been put to death while preaching to Muslims in North Africa. Upon arriving in Morocco to partake in this same work, Anthony became seriously ill, and the ship returning him to Portugal was blown off course to Sicily. It was in Italy that the young priest remained until his death at the age of 36. Anthony achieved great success as a confessor and preacher of parish missions, and St. Francis appointed him as the new order's first professor of theology to his fellow friars.

Anthony is portrayed holding the infant Jesus because a visitor witnessed this during a vision Anthony received in prayer. Also, he is widely invoked for the return of lost articles. *St. Anthony of Padua, pray for us!*
