

CENTENNIAL CAMPAIGN TOPS \$200,000 & 10% MATCHING GRANT AWARDED FROM CATHOLIC FOUNDATION



On May 7, we kicked off the Centennial Campaign. In just five weeks, we have 74 gifts and pledges totaling \$209,490. Thank you to all who have pledged and will pledge for our Centennial Campaign!

In addition, this week the Catholic Foundation awarded St. Anthony of Padua Church a Hommerding Incentive Fund Grant of up to \$45,000 toward the facilities portion of the St. Anthony Centennial Campaign.

Hommerding grants are restricted to capital improvement projects within the diocese. The grant is based on \$1 matched for every \$10 raised for the sanctuary re-design, church painting, ceiling cleaning/sealing, and pews.

Matching funds are available as pledges are paid and cash is received by the parish. For example, if someone made an unrestricted gift of \$10,000 to the Centennial Campaign, it would be matched with \$1,000 from the Hommerding Incentive Fund.

A number of people are considering a *restricted* gift of \$5,000 or more earmarked *specifically for the endowment*, so that their gift might be eligible for a 40% state tax credit. Though attractive because of the special North Dakota Endowment Tax Credit, please note that gifts restricted for the endowment are not eligible for the Hommerding Incentive Fund match.



Among a host of other needs we meet, this includes a food pantry accessible weekdays as well as providing warm daily meals that can be counted on. We recognize that focusing on the future is difficult when a young person is hungry and doesn't know where their next meal is coming from. In this spirit, Just One



Dwight was born to teenage runaway parents and a life of homelessness is all he has known.

He was surrounded by drugs and chaos his entire childhood. His father was murdered when he was four years old, and when his mother wasn't in jail for drug use, he moved around various homeless shelters in the Twin Cities when they weren't sleeping on the floors of strangers' homes. When she was in jail, he bounced around to various relatives.

Dwight attended 15 schools and, remarkably, made it through the 11th grade. He was lost for a few years, but made his way to Fraser's Stepping Stones Resource Center. He moved into his first and only home at the age of 21 when he got his own apartment in The Butler House. He is working full-time and getting his GED.




