<u>HOLY WEEK SIGN UP:</u> EMHCs, Proclaimers, Mass Coordinators, Ushers, and Altar Servers can volunteer for the upcoming Triduum Liturgies by signing up on the sheets in the Sacristy or contacting Samantha at the Parish Office. Please take a moment and sign up today!

<u>DECORATING</u>: The Liturgy Committee will decorate the church several times this week. Any help would be appreciated as we prepare our church for Holy Week. We will be decorating the church on:

- Wednesday, March 23 after the Tenebrae Service
- Thursday, March 24 after the Holy Thursday Mass
- Saturday, March 26 at 9:00 AM

<u>ADORATION ON HOLY THURSDAY:</u> There will be no regularly scheduled Adoration on Holy Thursday, March 24. Adoration of the Holy Eucharist will take place after the Holy Thursday Mass until Midnight.

<u>CHRISM MASS</u>: Everyone is encouraged to attend the Chrism Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral on Tuesday, March 22 at 11:00 AM. This is the yearly ceremony at which the Holy Oils used in the administration of the Sacraments – Oil of Catechumens (Baptism), Oil of Anointing (Anointing of the Sick) and Chrism (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Orders) – are blessed for all of the churches in the Diocese by the Bishop. We are indeed blessed to have the opportunity to witness this beautiful Liturgy in our home city!

<u>A REMINDER TO BOW:</u> Following the Holy Thursday Mass until the Consecration at the Easter Vigil Mass, the Blessed Sacrament will not be in the tabernacle. There is no need to genuflect, as Our Lord is not present under the Sacred Species. A simple bow to reverence the altar is proper during this time.

GOOD FRIDAY REMINDER: Please remember to bring back the nails that were given out on Ash Wednesday to our Good Friday Service. The nails that you meditated on throughout Lent will be returned during the Veneration of the Cross on Good Friday.

<u>LENTEN CANISTERS:</u> Please return your Lenten Canisters at any time during Holy Week. If you did not get a canister but would like to give to this special collection, you may use the envelope labeled "Lent Offering" in your contribution packet or simply leave a donation clearly marked. Donations will go to our local St. Vincent de Paul Conference, And Then There Were None and Heifer International. Checks should be made payable to St. Anthony's Church.

<u>INCENSE</u>: Please note that we will be using incense at the Easter Vigil, March 26 at 8:30 PM and on Easter Sunday, March 27 at the 9:00 AM and 10:30 AM Masses. If you or a family member is allergic or sensitive to the incense then we encourage you to attend the 7:30 AM Mass on Easter Sunday.

<u>DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET NOVENA:</u> One way to celebrate the redemptive Passion and Resurrection of our Lord is to participate in the Novena of the Divine Mercy. We will begin such a novena by reciting the Divine Mercy Chaplet on Good Friday, March 25 at 2:45 PM (followed by the Stations of the Cross at 3:00 PM). The novena will continue until Sunday, April 3. Join us in this powerful prayer at 3:00 PM each day in the church.

Good Friday Collection

Pope Francis has asked our parish to support Christians in the Holy Land.

Through the Good Friday Collection, you join with Catholics around the world to stand in solidarity with the Church in the Holy Land. When you contribute to the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, you become an instrument of peace in a troubled land.


