# **A Vincentian Vocation**



God issues a vocation to holiness to each member of the laity, which is manifested in daily work and activity. "The laity live in the world... They live in the ordinary conditions of life in the family and in society, from which the web of their existence is woven. They are called there by God so that by exercising their proper role and being led by the spirit of the Gospel they can work for the sanctification of the world from within, in the manner of leaven. In this way they can make Christ

known to others, especially by the testimony of a life resplendent in faith, hope and charity." (Lumen Gentium, #31). At 15, Frederic Ozanam suffered a severe crisis of faith. He prayed to the Holy Spirit and asked for the gift of faith, the grace to believe. When the crisis ended he promised to consecrate his life to the defense of the Faith and the service of truth. For the rest of his life, Frederic lived his faith, loved the Church and as a Vincentian, he made Christ known to the poor and suffering. *Is God calling me to be a Vincentian?*
