CHARITY IN ACTION Tax refunds have found their way into the pockets of our friends in need, so your parish St. Vincent de Paul Conference got a little breather in April. We fielded 60 phone calls resulting in 8 home visits, 26 referrals to other agencies, and 32 donated food baskets. Over \$1,400 was distributed this past month to provide assistance with: rent, phone cards, car window repair, car registration renewal, and insurance. An estimated 79 people received assistance in the form of funds and food. One upcoming challenge involves a young single dad who left his community to get his young son away from the drug abuse occurring within the family. We hope to journey with him as he searches for suitable employment and finds the confidence needed to be a single parent. Thank you for your continued support to help families in need, especially the recent Lenten donation of \$2,995! 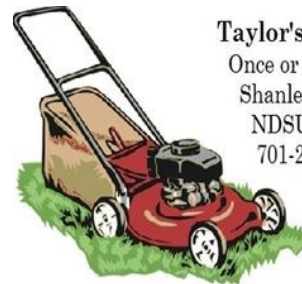
