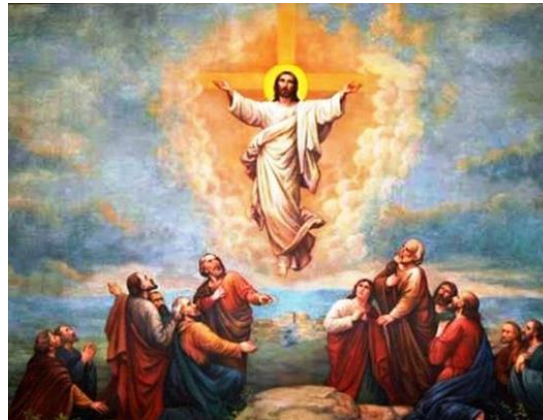

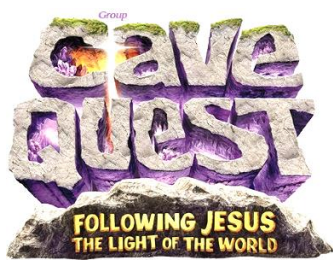
## Religious Education

---



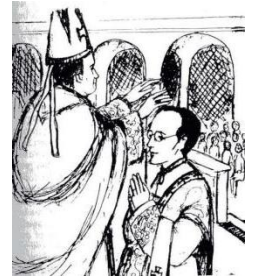

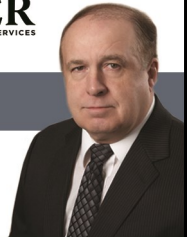
