Pray for the Poor Souls in Purgatory!

Ord, who art ever merciful and bounteous with Thy gifts, look down upon the suffering souls in purgatory. Remember not their offenses and negligences, but be mindful of Thy loving mercy, which is from all eternity. Cleanse them of their sins and fulfill their ardent desires that they may be made worthy to behold Thee face to face in Thy glory. May they soon be united with Thee and hear those blessed words which will call them to their heavenly home: "Come, blessed of My Father, take possession of the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world."

Indulgenced Acts applicable to the Poor Souls:

One can obtain a plenary indulgence by visiting a cemetery each day November 1 to November 8.

A plenary indulgence is also granted when the faithful piously **visit a church on November 2**. In visiting the church it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.

A partial indulgence can be obtained by **devoutly visiting a cemetery and praying for the departed any day of the year**, even if the prayer is only mental.

A partial indulgence can be obtained when the *Eternal Rest (Requiem aeternam)* is prayed. This can be prayed all year, but especially during the month of November:

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord; And let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.

(In addition to the action performed, the ordinary conditions for a <u>plenary indulgence</u> apply: disposition of detachment to all sin, sacramental confession of ones sins, reception of Holy Communion, and prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father.)
