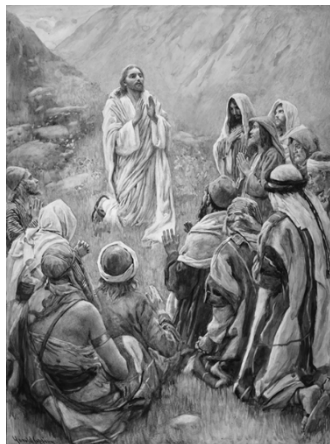

ALPHA, INQUIRY, and RCIA: MANY NAMES, ONE POWERFUL COURSE Over the past year, St. Anthony's has offered the RETURN course three different times, helping many to learn the best way to bring loved ones back into the faith. One of the common concerns those in attendance voiced was that their loved one didn't want to come to any event that seemed so... "Catholic." However, that may mean many of those loved ones (and those Catholics who want a refresher) ARE open to learning the basics of Christianity: Who was Jesus? Why did He come? Why did He die? And what does this matter to me, 2,000 years later? Alpha ('the beginning') is the experience that answers these questions. These sessions will also give current Catholics and Catholics-to-be a chance to grapple with the day-to-day questions on living out our purpose as Catholics: to know, love, and serve God in this world so that we can be happy with Him in the next. We will have the Alpha program 11 consecutive Thursdays, starting this Thursday at 7:00 PM, upstairs in the Cabrini Room (203). All are welcome. A note that this course will also serve as approximately the first third of our parish's RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) process for those wanting to be received into the Catholic Church on Easter. 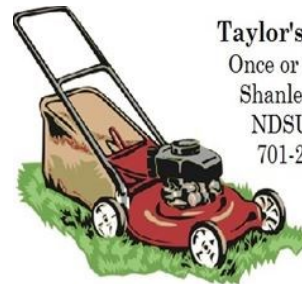
