

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I offer you the following reflections for your Lenten journey:

"How great is your goodness, Lord, stored up for those who fear you, You display it for those who trust you, in the sight of all the people. Be strong and take heart, all you who hope in the Lord." (Ps 31:20;25)

"Be still before the Lord; wait for God." (Ps 31:7a)

"Silence is a sword in the spiritual struggle....We are sensitive to words and quickly want to answer back, without taking any regard as to whether it is God's will that we should speak. A silent soul is strong; no adversities will harm it if it perseveres in the silence. The silent (198) soul is capable of attaining the closest union with God.
