## From Fr. Tom Reilly



My Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

For our preparation for Divine Mercy Sunday, I offer the following reflection from Jesus to Saint Faustina in the early 1930s. Jesus said to Saint Faustina:

My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy.

The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day are opened all the divine floodgates through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity.

The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy. (Diary Entry #699)

Yes. The first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be acts of mercy.... I demand from you deeds of mercy, which are to arise out of love for Me. You are to show mercy to your neighbors always and everywhere. You must not shrink from this or try to excuse or absolve yourself from it (#742).

Thus, to observe Divine Mercy Sunday in a solemn way, we should:

- 1. Celebrate the Feast on the Sunday after Easter;
- 2. Truly repent of all our sins;
- 3. Place our full trust in Jesus;
- 4. Go to Confession, preferably before that Sunday;
- 5. Receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast;
- 6. Venerate the Image of The Divine Mercy. (To venerate a sacred image or statue means to perform some act of make some gesture of deep religious respect toward it because of the person whom it represents; in this case, our Most Merciful Savior);
- 7. Be merciful to others by our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.




