Lenten Regulations

- ◆ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are Days of Fast and Abstinence.
- ◆ All Fridays of Lent are days of complete Abstinence.
- ◆ The Law of Abstinence forbids meat and is binding on everyone 14 years of age and older, health permitting.
- ◆ The Law of Fast prescribes that only one full meal be taken in a day. It permits two other lesser meals sufficient to maintain strength. It binds all, health permitting, from their 18th to their 59th birthdays.
- ◆ The time for the fulfillment of the Easter Communion precept extends from the First Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday, inclusive.
