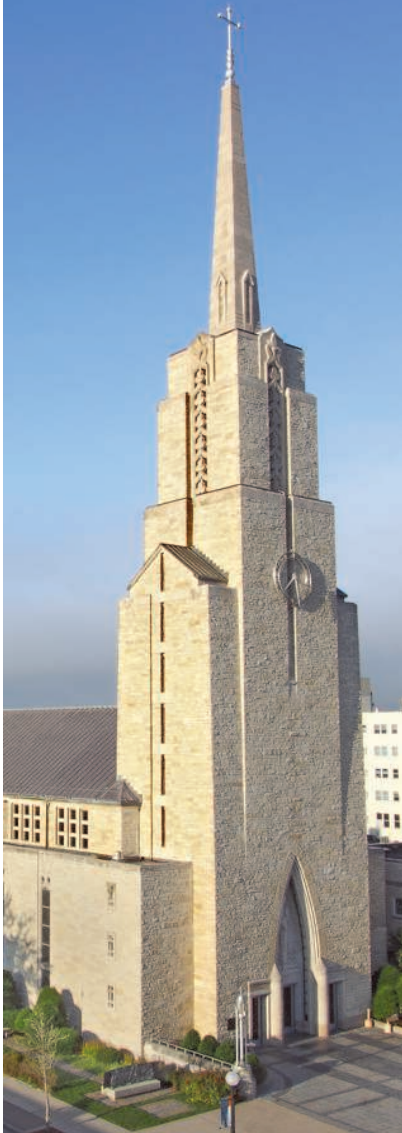

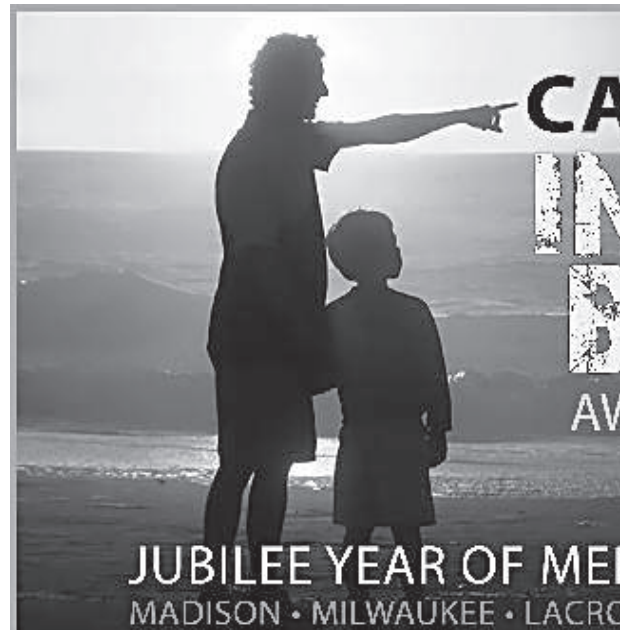

LENTEN WEEKDAY SERVICES

The schedule of Masses and confessions during the weekdays of Lent is the same as in Ordinary Time. In addition there are Stations of the Cross on weekdays at 11:40 am. There is exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on the Fridays of Lent after the 12:10 pm Mass until Benediction after the Stations of the Cross at 5:10 pm.

LENTEN SOUP SUPPERS

The Cathedral Parish continues its Lenten Soup Suppers during the Friday's of Lent. The evening opens with Stations of the Cross and Benediction at 5:10 pm, followed by a soup supper in the Undercroft. As in other years the people of the parish are being asked to donate yeast or sweetbreads for each of the suppers. They can be dropped off in the Undercroft near the kitchen. The Cathedral Education Committee has adopted the mission of generating funds to purchase materials for struggling learners at Aquinas Middle and High Schools. All donations from the Lenten Soup Suppers go towards this project.

PRAYER AND CONFESSIONS

Our Holy Father has asked that in this Jubilee Year of Mercy there be extended prayer and confessions before the Fourth Sunday of Lent (March 6th) when we will hear the gospel passage from the gospel of St. Luke on the Prodigal Sunday. In our deanery, the priests decided that since the all-day confession is a tradition it would be most appropriate to have the sacrament available. The date is Friday, March 4th at the Cathedral from 1:00 – 9:00 PM. This gives those who cannot come earlier a chance to go to confession. Even though there will be the all-day on Monday, March 21st, you are encouraged to come on the 4th if at all possible. There will be four priests hearing every hour. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed from after the 12:10 PM Mass through the end of Stations of the Cross at 5:10 PM.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

ABSTINENCE from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

FASTING is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this law may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these minimal prescribed penitential practices.

ROSARY

The Rosary is prayed prior to Mass, Monday through Friday at 7:35 am.
