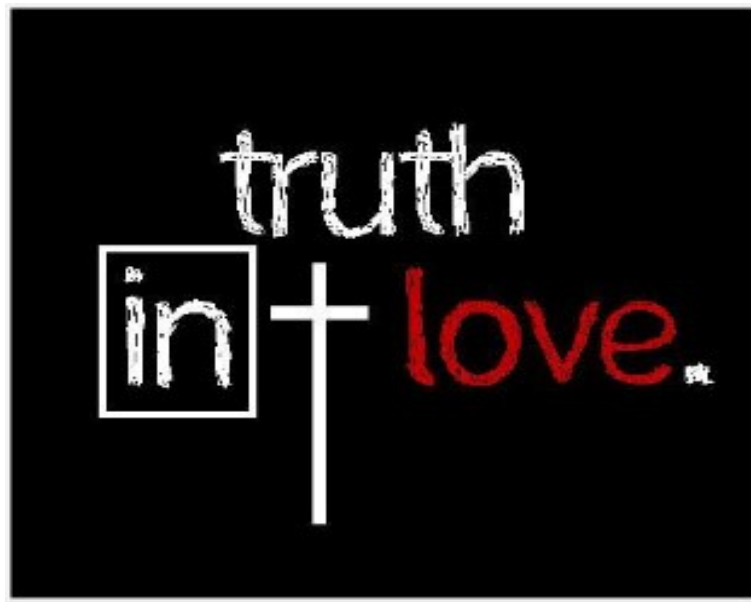

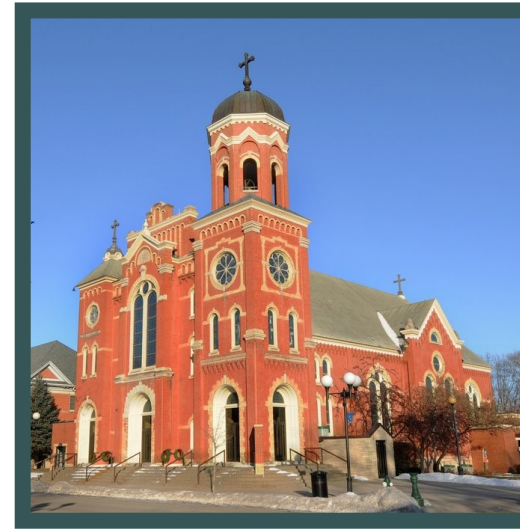

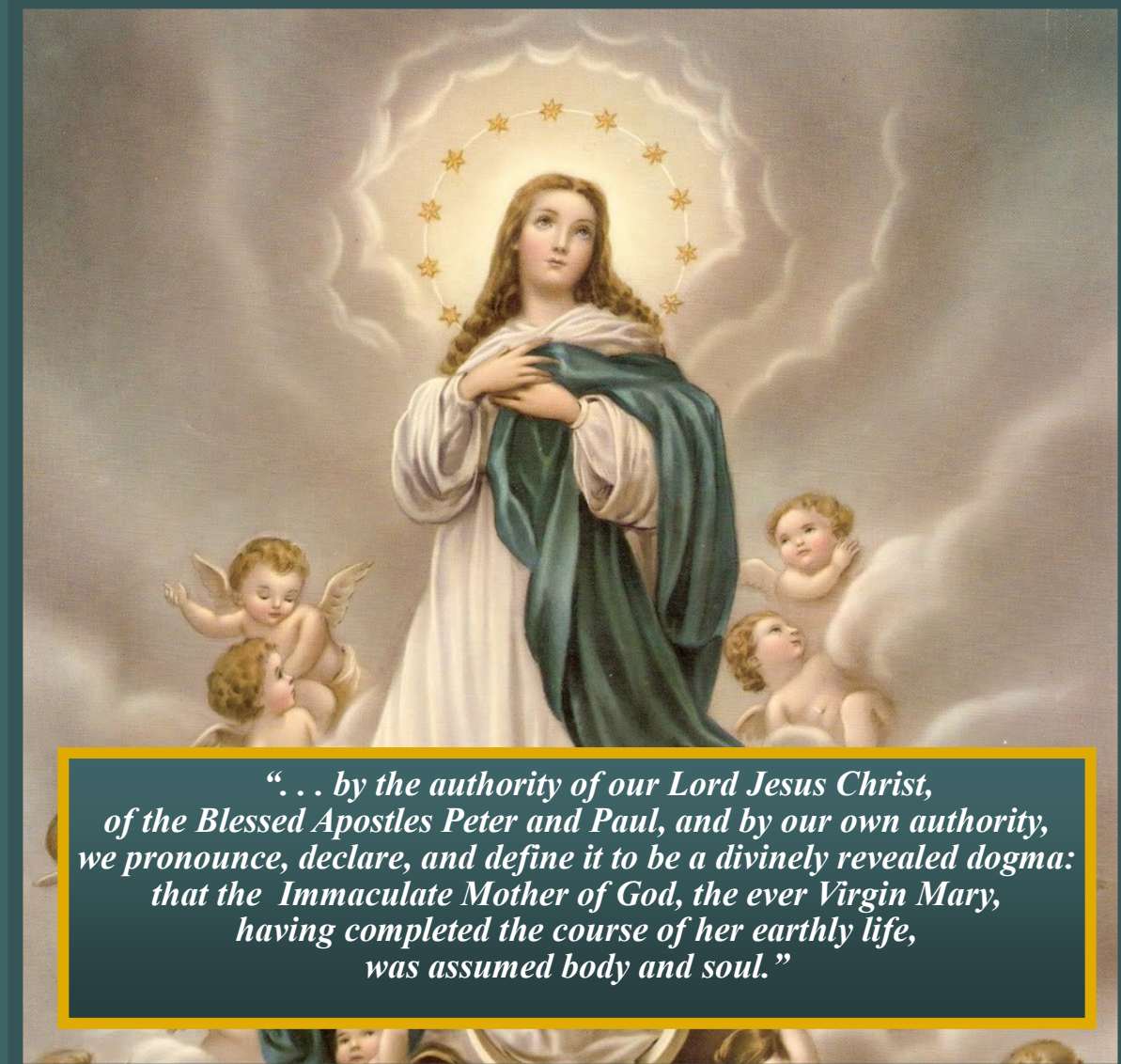

**Socialism is EVIL – the unchanged Truth of the Catholic Church**

Pope PIUS IX, pope from 1846-1878, published his Encyclical *Nostis et Nobiscum*, on December 8, 1849, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception:  
"You are aware indeed, that the goal of this most iniquitous plot is to drive people to overthrow the entire order of human affairs and to draw them over to the wicked theories of this Socialism and Communism, by confusing them with perverted teachings."



Pope St. John XXIII, Pope from 1958-1963, in his 1961 Encyclical *Mater et Magistra*, wrote that "No Catholic could subscribe even to moderate socialism."



Pope Benedict XV, pope from 1914-1922, wrote in his 1914 Encyclical *Ad Beatissimi Apostolorum*:  
"... the condemnation of socialism should never be forgotten."

**From 1846-2013, 11 straight popes, including 2 Saints, condemned socialism. Understand that ZERO faithful Catholics voted for Bernie Sanders or the commie mayor of NYC. Zero.**
