~Jesus Invites... St. Joan of Arc Welcomes~

Jesus restored life to Lazarus, to the daughter of Jairus, and to a widow's son. These three stunning acts of compassion were preceded by pleas from family members. The story of Jairus' daughter is found in all three synoptic Gospels, Matthew, Mark and Luke. The story begins with the father falling at Jesus' feet, pleading for the life of his child. On his way to the dying daughter, Jesus passes by a woman who reaches out to touch his cloak. She is immediately healed of her hemorrhage. The daughter dies before Jesus gets to Jairus' house, but even then, Jesus restores her. Today's Gospel assures us that with fervent prayer and our own absolute confidence in Jesus, we too, can reach out to touch the power of Christ, who saves even when all seems to be lost.

- Perhaps you are already “Catholic” and want to know the reasons why.

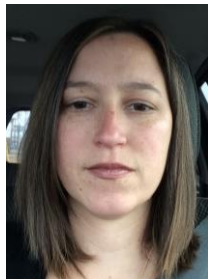
