### HAITIAN COMMUNITY'S ANNOUNCEMENTS ANNONCES DE LA COMMUNAUTE HAITIENNE

1. Notre-Dame de la Salette est le vocable sous lequel est appelée la Vierge Marie à l'occasion d'apparitions dans la commune de La Salette dans l'Isère en France. La Vierge y serait apparue le 19 septembre 1846 à deux enfants, une bergère de quinze ans Mélanie Calvat et un jeune berger de onze ans Maximin Giraud. Tous deux virent dans une lumière resplendissante une 'belle dame' vêtue d'un costume étrange. Mélangeant français et patois, elle s'est plainte de l'impiété des chrétiens et les a avertis du danger qui les menace s'ils continuent dans le mal. Elle leur confie un message de conversion, pour "tout son peuple". L'émotion provoquée par le récit de Mélanie et de Maximin fut vive. Mgr Philibert de Bruillard, évêque de Grenoble, nomma une commission pour examiner l'événement de manière prudente. Celle-ci conclut qu'il fallait admettre la réalité de l'apparition. Bientôt plusieurs guérisons miraculeuses survinrent sur la montagne de la Salette et les pèlerinages y commencèrent. La première pierre d'une grande église fut solennellement posée sur la montagne le 25 mai 1852. Cette église, plus tard promue au rang de basilique, fut desservie par des religieux appelés missionnaires de la Salette.

Vous êtes priés d'amener avec vous votre invité à cette grande fête du Christ notre Roi, le Roi de l'univers. Soyez gentil, courtois, et accueillant! Cédez votre place aux invités et nouveaux-venus.

### From Fr. Carlos

Throughout the scriptures we see Jesus perform some amazing feats. We read about Him calming storms, healing the afflicted, and raising the dead. Throughout His various miracles Jesus shows Himself as the Lord of all creation, as He manifests His power over everything, even over life and death. He does not stop there though, not only does He continue to work amazing feats in our lives, He also promises that we can do the same.

The ability to do things like turn water into wine might seem pretty convenient the next time you want to throw a party, but if that's where we leave things then we're missing the point. It's not about the wine; it's not even about the miracle, it is about the faith behind the miraculous event. In today's gospel passage, Jesus reminds His listeners about how much power is within their reach. He reminds them that a little faith is enough to uproot trees, to move mountains or even to transform the world. He makes this promise to each one of us, and yet as we look at the ordinariness of our daily existence such promises may seem far beyond our reach. God places them within our reach through the gift of faith. Faith is one of the greatest gifts that God gives us and perhaps one of the ones we understand the least.

Part of the reason that faith may seem mysterious to us is that we often settle for keeping our faith at a basic level. We trust that God is active. We seek Him when we need things, but we do not go too far beyond that. Such a relationship with God is certainly a start, but it is not enough. Placing our faith in God is not simply about having God answer our prayers; it's also about allowing God to transform us. God does not tell us that if we have faith then He will listen more eagerly to our prayers. He tells us that if we have faith great power will be within our reach. Deepening our faith and strengthening our relationship with God allows us to participate in His divine life and His divine power. We see this played out clearly in the lives of the saints. We see it in the example of the martyrs who are strengthened to give witness to Jesus' saving message even in the face of persecution and death. We also see it in the many missionaries and founders of religious orders who have been willing to give up all comfort and security to share Jesus' love with the whole world. The lives of the saints are inspiring and amazing, but they're really nothing other than the lives of Christians who were willing to take Jesus at His word and willing to live accordingly. Those same remarkable lives are within our grasp if only we're willing to trust that Jesus truly does want to do amazing things in our lives and that He wants us to be His instruments to do amazing things in the lives of others.

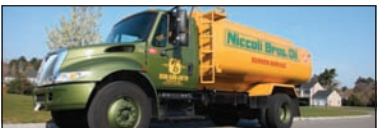
