### HAITIAN COMMUNITY'S ANNOUNCEMENTS ANNONCES DE LA COMMUNAUTE HAITIENNE

1. Notre-Dame de la Salette est le vocable sous lequel est appelée la Vierge Marie à l'occasion d'apparitions dans la commune de La Salette dans l'Isère en France. La Vierge y serait apparue le 19 septembre 1846 à deux enfants, une bergère de quinze ans Mélanie Calvat et un jeune berger de onze ans Maximin Giraud. Tous deux virent dans une lumière resplendissante une 'belle dame' vêtue d'un costume étrange. Mélangeant français et patois, elle s'est plainte de l'impiété des chrétiens et les a avertis du danger qui les menace s'ils continuent dans le mal. Elle leur confie un message de conversion, pour "tout son peuple". L'émotion provoquée par le récit de Mélanie et de Maximin fut vive. Mgr Philibert de Bruillard, évêque de Grenoble, nomma une commission pour examiner l'événement de manière prudente. Celle-ci conclut qu'il fallait admettre la réalité de l'apparition. Bientôt plusieurs guérisons miraculeuses survinrent sur la montagne de la Salette et les pèlerinages y commencèrent. La première pierre d'une grande église fut solennellement posée sur la montagne le 25 mai 1852. Cette église, plus tard promue au rang de basilique, fut desservie par des religieux appelés missionnaires de la Salette.

### From Fr. Carlos

Lepers abound throughout the scripture. Leprosy, now known as Hansen's Disease, can be highly contagious, debilitating and disfiguring to those who are infected with it. Thankfully, nowadays, it's not very common and it's also very treatable. However, in the ancient world it was poorly understood and it was so feared that not only those with true leprosy, but also those with any skin condition that looked like it might be leprosy, were cast out to the margins of society. As with any legitimate fear, there were good reasons for these hygienic laws and regulations, but like any fear the response often went far beyond the problem. Lepers were total outcasts. It often happened that out of fear of the disease, the basic humanity of the sick person would be forgotten.

Jesus showed us a different way. He showed us that those in the margins are as much a vital and necessary part of the human community as the healthiest and most productive person is. He regularly went to the margins and often went beyond the margins to tend to those whom others would like to forget. An interesting thing too, is how simple the cures or miraculous cures of leprosy were. Because the disease had such a heavy weight, people like Naaman, in today's first reading, expected that the cure would be just as weighty. However, in his case all Naaman had to do was to bathe; and in the case of the Lepers of the gospel, all it took for them to be cured was encountering Jesus along the road.

Thankfully Hansen's Disease isn't a great concern these days, but there are other physical and spiritual forms of leprosy which still need Jesus' healing touch. This healing takes place through that same encounter with Jesus. The saints knew this and in the example of their lives we can see how they lived it out. In the example of saints like Saint Damien of Molokai or Blessed Teresa of Calcutta we see those who were willing to go to the margins and tend to the physical needs of the body of Christ without considering the toll it might take on them. There are also those saints who did the same on a spiritual level, going out across the globe, raising up the poor, feeding the hungry, instructing the ignorant and healing that wound which comes from living with the brokenness of human nature without knowing the love of Jesus.

We too, must follow in the footsteps of our Lord and of the saints. This journey of bringing healing and hope to others begins with that difficult first step of recognizing our own need for healing. As St. Paul reminds us, all of us deal with the wounds of sin (Romans 3:23) and so that's the first healing we need. The confessional is not a judge's bench but rather a hospital where those of us called to be saints can come to be strengthened and healed. This spiritual healing may seem difficult, but all it really takes is that same encounter with Jesus that the Lepers had on the road. Through the sacraments and through our lives of prayer that's all Jesus wants to do, to heal us and to set us free. We need this, not only so that we can live more peaceful and fulfilling lives but also so that we can accomplish the second part of our mission and go out and bring that healing and saving message to so many others who still live on the margins and wander in darkness. It doesn't take much to begin this journey but what we receive in return will surely surpass our expectations.

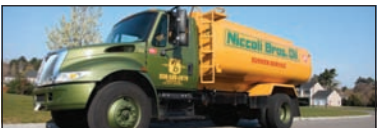
