#### From Fr. Carlos

The readings this week call on us to reflect on the power of prayer, in particular the power of intercessory prayer. Prayer should be that constant lifeblood that draws us deeper in relationship with God. It also serves to key us into the need for those around us. The fact is, that for many of us, prayer remains too superficial an experience which barely scratches at the surface of the heart without penetrating deep within.

We are blessed to have a rich treasury of prayers which have been handed down throughout time and which unite our voices together as the body of Christ. These truly powerful prayers lead us to experience the depths of God's glory. So too, in more private moments we can experience the depths of God's mercy and forgiveness through an act of contrition and hearing the beautiful words of the prayer of absolution which sets us free from the weight of our sin. The sacrament of reconciliation reminds us that yes, sin and Hell are real and we should strive to avoid them, but when we fall what we encounter is not the wrath of an angry God, but rather the hand of a loving Father who yearns for us to rise again and to be healed.

These set and mostly scripted moments of prayer guide and nourish us on our journey as Christians, however, God calls us to go deeper. We recall that prayer should be at its very core, a conversation with God, where we recognize our connection with Him and the many graces which He pours forth into our lives because of that connection. All prayer falls into one of four basic categories: Petition, Intercession, Thanksgiving, and Praise.

The reading this week highlights for us the importance of intercessory prayer. We witness the power of intercessory prayer in the scriptures, in the life of the Church and even in secular studies, which look at scenarios such as: how the prayer of loved ones affects a patient in the hospital. We may wonder why we need intercessory prayer. Perhaps we wonder what purpose our poor words and limited attention may serve in the presence of an almighty all-knowing God. In the face of these questions and doubts we should remember that intercessory prayer is powerful, because we are often the instruments through which God chooses to manifest His power. We see this in today's reading from the Book of Exodus when Aaron and Hur show us, in a physical way, what intercessory prayer does for us spiritually. As they support Moses' hands, Aaron and Hur strengthen him for his mission and help to turn the tide of battle.

In the same way, God places people in our lives and asks us to pray for them. This prayer mission includes praying for those we are closest to as much as it includes total strangers. As difficult as it may be to pray for some people, we have to remember that we are God's instrument and therefore we may not always understand what God asks us to do. However, the more we cooperate with God, the more we begin to see the bigger picture and the more we can appreciate the power of our prayer in the lives of others. Our prayers may seem like small and imperfect gestures, but when given to God even the smallest gesture has infinite results.


