Every so often the local paper has a feature article that looks at news that is weird, silly or a major waste of money. One article took a look at research projects that had been funded by grants whose conclusions seemed obvious. "People eat more ice cream in summer," "Cars last longer when well maintained," and "Students do better when they eat breakfast" are more common sense than mysteries that need to be explored. Do we really need to spend time and money to study the obvious? Common sense is not so common!

The practice of religion does not escape the weird, the silly or the waste of money, especially when it meets up with politics. Every year, there is one controversy or another about Halloween, focusing on costumes, or meaning, or the fear of demonic possession because a three year old wears a devil's costume. Would that the devil be so obvious! It is important to remember the origins of Halloween and reclaim the honor and memory of the saints who we celebrate tomorrow on All Saints Day. Instead of hiding behind costumes and political correctness, it might be time to stand with history and meaning and mission. Maybe kids should dress as saints and tell the story of the holy men and women on whose shoulders we stand. Perhaps it is time to celebrate the 'holy eve' with joy. But if a little devil with a candy basket can cancel a party or school celebration, just imagine what the real Evil One can do.

From Fr. Carlos

In the course of the past two days we've celebrated All Saints Day and All Souls Day, and the way the calendar falls this year these celebrations lead right into the Sunday celebration. This gives us a blessed opportunity to reflect on our salvation. Each Sunday we celebrate Christ's resurrection, but with these other two feasts we're also reminded of how we fit into Christ's saving mission. It's a currently popular notion that everyone automatically goes to Heaven. However, this isn't exactly so. Heaven is the destination we're all intended for. God desires eternal union with all of us in Heaven, but whether we get there or not depends largely upon us.

As we celebrate the feast of All Saints we're reminded of those men and women throughout the life of the Church who have taken this mission seriously and who have worked out their salvation with fear and trembling as St. Paul encouraged us to do in his letter to the Philippians(Phil 2:12). Those people that we hold up as saints come from backgrounds as varied as any person on the face of the Earth, but at the moment God touched their hearts, they turned radically toward Him and away from anything that would have lessened that bond. It's not an easy decision to make, we know that for many it involved sacrificing relationships, well-being, and even giving up their lives. Such sacrifices might seem beyond our strength, and they are, but the saints show us that when we're faithful to following God, and when we allow Him to transform us, then we easily realize that there's nothing worth more than His love and that there's no price too high to pay in order to give witness to that love.

All Souls' Day, or the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed, invites us to remember those of our loved ones who have gone on before us. There's a reason that the liturgical color of this day is specifically violet or black and not the white of All Saints, and that's because it reminds us that those who died but who didn't have saintly perfection still need our prayers.

Most of our protestant brothers and sisters don't understand the Church's teaching on purgatory or on praying for the dead, but both these beliefs are solidly grounded in Christian tradition and in scripture. In the Second Book of Maccabees, Judas Maccabe orders that sacrifices be offered in the temple for slain Jewish soldiers who had died and who had been found to be wearing pagan amulets (2Mac 12:38-46). The belief is clearly that the prayers would atone for their embrace of pagan superstition. In the New Testament we see St. Paul praying for Onesiphorus, who had died (2 Tim 1:18). In St. Paul's Letter to the Hebrews (Heb 12:23) we see one of many references in the scriptures to purgatory. The spirits of just men who died in godliness are "made" perfect. They do not necessarily arrive perfect. They are made perfect after their death, but those in Heaven are already perfect and those in hell can no longer be made perfect. Therefore St. Paul is speaking of the souls in purgatory. Far from being a negative thing, Purgatory is a wonderful gift from God. The souls that go through this process of purification know they're heading toward Heaven, but they need that final cleansing to be freed from any stain of sin. Therefore as we celebrate these days, let us remember to pray for our loved ones who have gone before us, and let us commit ourselves anew to following the example of the saints so that one day we may rejoice with them and with our loved ones forever in Heaven.
