La Dédicace de la Basilique du Latran le 9 novembre. Après la fête de l'Église du ciel le 1^{er} novembre et celle de l'Église du purgatoire le 2 novembre, c'est en quelque sorte la fête de l'Église de la terre que nous célébrons avec la dédicace de la Basilique Saint Jean de Latran. Aux premiers siècles du christianisme, l'Église persécutée ne put bâtir de temples et dut célébrer les divins mystères dans des maisons particulières ou dans les catacombes, sur les tombeaux des martyrs. Mais quand la paix fut donnée aux chrétiens, on vit bientôt surgir de toutes parts des temples magnifiques en l'honneur du seul vrai Dieu, sur les ruines des temples du paganisme. Le Christ et sa Croix rendirent l'empereur Constantin victorieux de son rival Maxence. Ne marchandant pas sa reconnaissance, le grand empereur mit fin aux persécutions sanglantes, donna la liberté à l'Église et fit construire à Rome sur l'emplacement du palais des Laterani la basilique du Saint-Sauveur, appelée aussi Basilique Saint Jean de Latran dont le pape saint Sylvestre fit la dédicace en 324. Cette fête mérite de notre part un respect tout spécial. Les édifices de nos églises nous montrent dans le temple la maison de prière, la maison de Dieu, une image de la céleste Jérusalem, la porte du Ciel. Même les pierres de nos églises nous parlent pour nous rappeler que nous sommes les pierres vivantes du Temple mystique que Dieu ne cesse de construire.

From Fr. Carlos

One of the traits that separate humans from the rest of creation is our desire for knowledge. Many animals possess the ability to learn and to deepen their awareness and interaction with the world around them, but we humans are unique both in our ability to understand that certain knowledge is beyond our grasp, and in our desire to attain that knowledge anyway. As with many of our traits, this thirst for knowledge can develop in an excellent way or in a warped way. Developed along the path of excellence this thirst for knowledge is what has led to many human achievements such as the vast array of scientific exploration and discovery. Developed in a warped way, the quest for knowledge becomes the desire to possess knowledge that belongs only to God. This includes the desire to know things about the future as well as the desire to communicate with loved ones who have died. On relatively rare occasions, God reveals such knowledge to individuals, but many others try to seek that knowledge by doing things such as going to consult mediums, fortunetellers or psychics. In this regard, it is important to remember two things. First, the only skill the majority mediums and psychics have is the ability to get people to part easily with their hard-earned money. Secondly, when we seek that which God has put out of our reach there is always the potential that we open ourselves to something more sinister entering into our lives. If you have done it, go to confession. If you have not done it, don't waste your money. If God wants you to know something He will find a way to convey the message without you having to pay someone else what amounts to a spiritual "shipping and handling" fee.

Another area of divine knowledge that fascinates people is the timing of the end of the world. Scripture passages, such as today's gospel, have fed this desire for centuries. The early Christians expected that Our Lord would return in their lifetime. Since then there have been scores of self-appointed prophets who have focused on weighing the evidence and trying to calculate the date for the end of the world. As I've previously mentioned one of these proposed dates, May 21, 2011, holds special meaning and amusement for me. This date, which was forecast as the day the world would end, was also the day I was ordained a priest. All I wanted to know was whether the end would come in the morning or the evening. Would I have to plan an ordination reception or not? Many people were taken in by the preacher who was peddling this date for the end of the world, they sold all their possessions and use the money to buy up billboards all over the place, and yet here we are two and a half years after the fact. It has happened before and it will happen again, but we must remember that Our Lord clearly tells us that not even He knows when the end of the world will come (Mark 13:32). We may not like it, but there are certain things which God has chosen to leave shrouded in mystery. Fighting against God's will never end well. Instead let us ask Him for the grace to live at peace with His mystery and for an increase of faith so that we always walk with the firm conviction that God is with us and that He always shows us and gives us exactly what we need to meet the challenge of the present moment.
