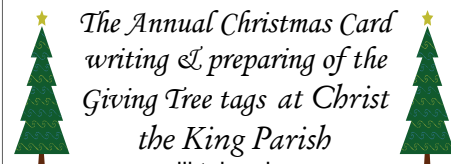

Fr. Walter Cizek, a Jesuit priest being promoted for sainthood, spent years in Russia as a political prisoner. In one of his books, "He Leadeth Me," he writes, "There is a tremendous truth contained in the realization that when God became man, He became a working man—not a king nor chieftain, not a warrior or statesmen, nor a great leader of nations." We celebrate Christ the King, not as a political figure or world leader, but as the King of the Cross where the work of salvation takes place. It is a work of love.

Subjects follow their king into battle. We follow Christ into battle with sin and with death. First, He shows us how to live in love as God intends as He teaches, preaches, heals and forgives. Then, through His death, He destroys the power of sin and evil over us and asks us to pick up the cross and follow Him. We honor Him as the Crucified King who suffers for our sins and gives us the hope of eternal life.

We serve the Lord and we follow Him. His kingship is one of service, love and humility. He invites rather than commands; he leads rather than directs. He is the Lord, the Savior, the Anointed and the Son of God. He is the victor, ruler and redeemer! But mostly, He is Jesus, our Brother, our King of love and of life.

From Fr. Carlos

Happy Feast! As we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King today we're reminded of just what sort of king Christ is. Jesus went unrecognized as a king and challenged by many of his coreligionists in His time because they awaited a messiah who would wield political power and who would overturn the tide of historical events. Some hoped that they would go from being the conquered people to being those in power. The mistake in all of this thinking is that they were thinking in purely horizontal terms; where what matters is power as humans see it, not power as God sees it. If God was like the ancients imagined Him to be, mercurial, vindictive, and wrathful, then maybe a militaristic messiah might have made sense. Jesus on the other hand came, "not to be served but to serve and to give His life as a ransom for many" (Mt 20:28).

The style of Jesus' kingship comes from what Jesus shows us about the nature of God. Jesus reveals the Trinity, Three Persons in one God, and He shows us that the bond between these three persons is love. Therefore in God there is no room for pettiness or revenge, but rather for a much more powerful way of being king. Jesus comes to rule not by fear but by conversion of hearts. Many of Jesus' actions during His life point to His divine and His kingly power. Yet one of the mysteries of Jesus remains is that his greatest throne was the cross and what seemed to be His greatest defeat was the greatest victory not only for Him but for all of us.

Jesus' cross should be central in our lives because much of our life is marked by the carrying of our own crosses. We can try to deny the crosses in our lives just as many churches have tried to move the crucifix out of the center of attention, but that's only an illusion - it doesn't really change anything. Jesus' cross is central to his mission and central to His kingship. In following Him we can't run from our crosses. Jesus tells us, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me" (Mt 16:24). We don't seek suffering for suffering's sake, but in embracing the suffering that enters our life from time to time we find the royal road to union with Jesus. As we experience suffering it is an opportunity to turn to Jesus and to ask Him to help us to carry our cross. As we accept these challenges and as we invite Jesus to walk with us, He also invites us to have our own increasing share in His glory.

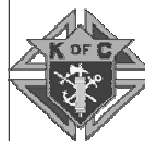
