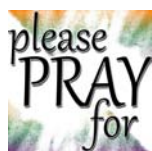

**From Fr. Carlos**

The gospel readings for the past three Sundays should sound somewhat similar. The transition between the end of one liturgical year and the beginning of the next liturgical year is connected by readings that reflect on the end of times and the victorious return of the Lord. It may seem strange that the Church chose these readings for the Sundays leading up to Christmas, but she does so, to remind us of the connection between Jesus' birth and His passion. Right from the beginning of His life, the shadow of the cross already hovers in the background. Not only is His birth and death united, they are also united to His returning in glory.

In light of this reality, the Church invites us to reflect on how we prepare for the Christmas season. Yes, there is room for joy and the celebration for presents and feasting, but there should be more. The season of advent doesn't have the somber penitential mood of the season of lent, but in adopting similar colors, this season does invite us to quiet things down a bit and to make time for reflection. It's easy to get caught up in the materialistic frenzy of shopping for the perfect gifts, but the satisfaction of this path only lasts until the novelty of the gifts wears off. In contrast, the Church invites us to spend this season on a much simpler mission. She invites us to reflect on what we're going to do to prepare to receive Christ anew at Christmas. In the silence of these days, the Church invites us to take stock of three things. First of all, we should reflect on the gifts God has given us over the past year. When we live day to day and when we allow ourselves to be burdened by the cares of daily life, it becomes more difficult to see the pattern of God's action in our life. So, it's important to step back and take stock. It's also important to acknowledge the ways we've dulled or closed off our openness to God's grace. Taking the time to make a good confession and setting aside our sins is a great way to live the season of Advent, to clear our spiritual house and to prepare room for our Lord. Lastly, just as children make lists of the gifts they most desire, we need to make a list of the gifts we most need from God for the coming year. What are the areas where we most need His help and transforming grace? God knows us better than we know ourselves, but expressing our needs to Him opens us to receive more deeply what God has in store for us. If we take this three part focus for our Advent season of giving thanks, asking forgiveness, and asking for God's gifts, we'll make it more peacefully through the frenzy of the holiday season and we'll be better prepared to live out the year ahead.

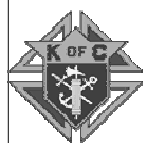
