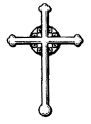

**A WORD FROM THE PASTOR**

There was a very touching story in the news last week about Pope Francis and a young boy who had a question for the pope. The Holy Father was visiting a parish on the crumbling outskirts of Rome, and there was time for questions between the pope (their bishop) and the parishioners. A young boy came forward, but he was too moved to speak. So they brought him to the Holy Father's chair, and the child, crying, melted into the pope's arms. The Holy Father told the boy to whisper his question in his ear. There was silence, and the pope nodded as the boy spoke, their heads touching. When he finished, the Holy Father asked the boy if he could share his story, and the boy said yes.

It turns out that the boy's father—described as a “non-believer”—had recently died. The boy said his father was a “good man” who had his four children baptized. Then the question: “Is my dad in heaven?”

“How beautiful to hear a son say of his father, ‘he was good,’” Pope Francis replied. “And what a beautiful witness of a son who inherited the strength of his father, who had courage to cry in front of all of us. If that man was able to make his children like that, then it's true, he was a good man. He was a good man.”

The Holy Father didn't say whether the boy's father was in heaven (“God is the one who says who goes to heaven”), but he assured the boy that God does not abandon his children. “God was surely proud of your father,” Pope Francis said. And since he had his children baptized, “surely this pleased God very much. Talk to your dad; pray to your dad.”

Earlier a young girl asked the Holy Father a similar question: “When we are baptized, we become children of God. People who aren't baptized, are they not children of God?” Like a true pastor, Pope Francis said to the girl, “What does your heart tell you?” She said, “They are children of God,” and the pope responded, “Right. We are all children of God. Everyone. Everyone.”

How different that response was to the answer I got when I asked my 2<sup>nd</sup> grade teacher if unbaptized babies go to heaven. She said, “No, they go to Limbo.” I didn't know what Limbo was, but it disturbed me. This remained the typical answer regarding unbaptized babies into my priesthood, until one wise pastor said to me, “Ask a mother what happens to her child who dies before Baptism.” I had that opportunity a short time later. And the response? “My child is with God.”

The question of salvation for Christians, let alone non-Christians, has vexed the Church from the very beginning. My homily last Sunday addressed this, but I point out here just one line from the Gospel: “I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. These also I must lead, and they will hear my voice, and there will be one flock, one shepherd.”

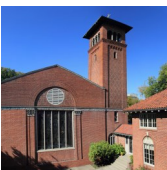
