

A Word from the Pastor

Planning for the Cathedral Project continues, and I want to give an update of our progress. Before I do, I want to make sure that people understand that, for the time being, our "parking lot" project is off the table. People have expressed to me the need for additional parking at cathedral, and I agree. There are two issues at stake: 1) the wisdom of selling or leasing cathedral property, and 2) the possibility of increasing parking. Tied into this is the type of housing we might develop, both mission-driven and financially feasible. After consultation with the Pastoral and Administrative Councils, and with the Archdiocese of Portland, it was decided to cease our marketing efforts and continue planning that will satisfy our collective goals. Thus, for the time being, we will retain our surface parking lot with the hope that, in the future, more creative proposals might emerge. I should add that we are still working with the Archdiocese of Portland on the "Burnside Block" (Enterprise Rent-A-Car). There is potential here for parking, and it's worth exploring.

Meanwhile, Archbishop Sample has moved out of his residence, and the first phase of the Cathedral Project has begun. This past week work began on the seismic upgrade of Cathedral School. This upgrade is needed in the older portions of Cathedral School, including the area around the gym. It is exciting that we are already seeing the fruits of our planning and our capital campaign. At the end of May, we reached our first financial goal: \$1 million in pledges. This allowed us to move forward with the seismic upgrade. That million-dollar goal was the result of 39 pledges to the capital campaign. A big thank you to all of those who pledged!

The goal we hope to achieve by the end of August is \$2,500,000. Our campaign consultant is Ed Lemma, and we have charted a plan through the summer that will hopefully take us to our goal. Since we achieved our last goal through careful and methodical planning, we are confident that we will also achieve our August goal. We are grateful to Archbishop Sample, the honorary chair of our campaign, for his generosity in hosting social functions at his former residence. This past week we had our third gathering with him, and it was a wonderful opportunity to express our hopes and dreams for St. Mary's Cathedral. As you probably know by now, the Cathedral Project encompasses the seismic upgrade of the school, the renovation and upgrade of Cathedral Center and archbishop's former residence, plus the courtyard of the cathedral and plaza on 17th street between the Cathedral Center and the school. With a capital campaign goal of \$8 million, this is an ambitious project for our parish and for our cathedral, but it is also very exciting. We can do it.

As we move into summer, our planning continues along two tracks: Track 1 is the capital campaign, and Track 2 is planning the renovation of our spaces. Keep the Cathedral Project in your prayers!
