#### A Word from the Pastor

For the past four years, the Administrative Council and I have been evaluating options to make better use of our parking lot (what we call the "Everett Block"). Previous Administrative Councils have done the same, all the way back to the mid-80's. Our goal has always been to retain or increase parking while, at the same time, providing a firm financial foundation for our parish and the cathedral.

Most recently, we engaged an experienced commercial real estate brokerage firm to solicit the development community to help us better understand what options might exist. As a result of that process, there were a number of interested parties with legitimate proposals, including offers to lease or purchase the block. The proposals all provided for parking, at least maintaining the current number of spaces.

Because the Everett Block is a significant asset to the parish (and part of the patrimony of the archdiocese), its sale or lease required consultation not only with our parish Pastoral and Administrative Councils but also with the archdiocese. The result of this consultation was a decision to cease the marketing effort. It was a hard decision to make, but the development proposals did not satisfy our collective goals. Thus, for the time being, we will retain our surface parking lot with the hope that, in the future, some better proposal might emerge.

Two positive results came out of our consultation with Archbishop Sample and the archdiocese. The first is that the archdiocese is committed to assisting the parish as best it can with ongoing maintenance of the cathedral. The second is a willingness to work with the parish to find ways to increase our parking. One valuable resource in this regard is the "Burnside Block," the piece of property owned by the archdiocese across from the school (between 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>). Should the archdiocese ever develop this property, it could include additional parking for cathedral.

For the time being, our primary focus will be the renovation of Cathedral Center (called the "Cathedral Project") and the capital campaign to fund it. The Cathedral Project is separate and independent of the Everett Block (our parking lot development) and should not be confused with it. All of us are quite excited about the possibilities that an expanded hall, a complementary courtyard, and new facilities will bring to the life of our parish. In fact, our goal in renovating is to create an atmosphere, with good facilities, in which our parish can attract new members and grow as a community. Archbishop Sample—the honorary chair of our fundraising campaign—is strongly committed to the Cathedral Project. In fact, I am happy to report that our fundraising efforts have already been quite successful. I will keep you posted on the progress of the capital campaign and the Cathedral Project in future Bulletin columns. For now, pray for the success of our Cathedral Project—and a renewed and energized spirit in our parish.


