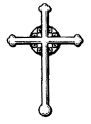

### **A WORD FROM THE PASTOR**

Today is the Solemnity of Christ the King, the last Sunday of the Church's liturgical year. It is a Sunday to think big thoughts, about the year just concluding, about the year ahead, and about the lives we Christians live each day.

At the end of the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus instructs his disciples in these words: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations; and behold, *I am with you always*, until the end of the age."

From ancient Galilee we jump ahead to the distant future, to the Parousia, The End. Jesus has come in glory with his angels. The Gospel has been preached to all nations, and now these nations are assembled before the great King, to give an accounting. One can imagine the mood: a little nervous, a little excited, wondering what is going to happen. The crowd looks pretty homogeneous, except that some are chubby and wooly and bleat; and the others are thin, short haired, and a little wired. All of a sudden, the sweeping hand of God separates the sheep and the goats, the sheep to the right and the goats to the left. In a moment they will all know the meaning of Jesus' final words, "Behold, *I am with you always*, until the end of the age.

The story of the sheep and the goats continues the Gospel themes of the past couple of weeks: the end times, and how we are to live in preparation for the end. All of us will be judged, and the Gospel today provides the criteria upon which that judgment will take place. And the criteria are surprising. Not keeping the Law. Not staying out of trouble. Nothing sexual. Instead, the criteria are the corporal works of mercy. Entrance into the Kingdom is dependent upon our loving care of each other.

Jesus says, "I was hungry, I was thirsty, I was a stranger, I was sick, I was naked, I was in prison." And the sheep and the goats rightly respond, "When did we see you in need?" Jesus might respond in this way: "Remember when I said that I would be with you always, until the end of the age? (Heads nod.) You thought I meant that only in a 'spiritual way.' In fact, I meant it quite literally. I was present with you in the poor." Then the sheep will say, "Really, we didn't know that!" And Jesus will say, "That's the beauty of it! You didn't know, but you served the poor anyway—without any expectation of reward." Hoping still to be saved, the goats pipe up, "*Had we known* that you were present in the poor, we certainly would have served you!" And Jesus will respond, "That's exactly the problem. You gave only if there was something in it for you. You did not give out of love." And the sheep entered into the Kingdom prepared for them; and the goats . . . well, they departed, accursed, into the eternal fire of Hell.

While we still have time, let us open our eyes, see Christ, and serve him in our brothers and sisters.

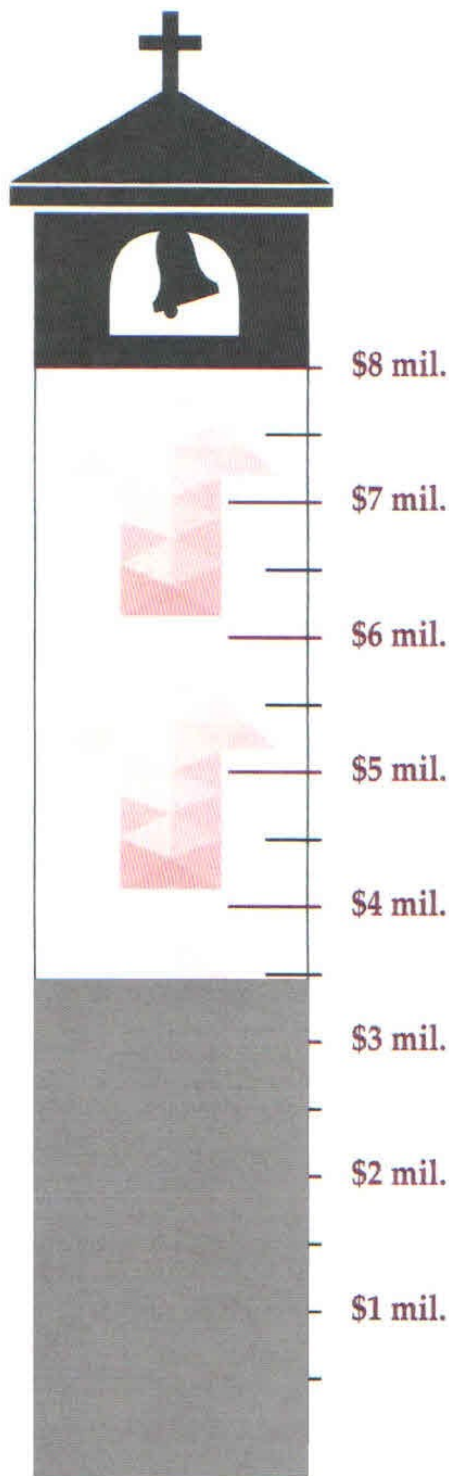
