#### A Word from the Pastor

By now most of you have received your packets with information about our Cathedral Project and our capital campaign. You have also seen the conceptual drawings done by Hacker Architects. These digital renderings give some idea of the remodel of our Cathedral Center and the courtyard, though these drawings are very preliminary. A working committee has been meeting with Hacker to refine our ideas and to decide the best use and placement of the various meeting rooms, classrooms, chapel, large hall, and commons. Most spaces are designated "multi-purpose" so that their use can be shared by as many parishioners and groups as possible. While the building may seem large, as soon as one situates a classroom or two, with the necessary closets, cabinets, storage areas, hallways, and bathrooms, the usable space quickly diminishes. The large hall, with a kitchen, will take up almost the entire second floor, while a portion of the third floor must be opened to the beams (looking up from the second-floor hall) to reduce the claustrophobic effect of a low ceiling. All things considered, we will try to incorporate as many usable spaces as we can, given the limitations of our four walls.

With that in mind, some have suggested that we tear down the building and start over—a practical consideration that oftentimes saves money. We continue to look at this suggestion, but we don't think such a drastic move would win approval either from the parish or from the city's landmarks commission. We live in the Alphabet Historic District, and, as such, there are restrictions on design. Fortunately, the Cathedral Center is a handsome, classic, century-old masonry building. It needs a seismic upgrade, and just about everything else internally; but externally, we can work with it.

It is now time to consider a pledge to our capital campaign, over a five-year period, that will help bring our dreams to fruition. More important to me than the amount of the pledge is broad participation and ownership on the part of the parish—as well as from our friends beyond the parish. In the past few months I have heard from many people who cherish the cathedral as the place where they were baptized, where their parents were married, where their grandparents had their funeral. Our cathedral is both a parish church and everyone's church the mother church of the Archdiocese of Portland. We are proud of our cathedral and our Catholic heritage, which extends back to the 1840's, when the Oregon Territory became a "vicariateapostolic" (forerunner of a diocese). My hope is that a renovated Cathedral Center, with a "welcome commons," will raise the profile of our Catholic presence in Portland and give us a beautiful space to gather, to socialize, to study, and to pray.

But we need your help. We need everyone's help. In the next couple of weeks we will be asking you to make a pledge to our capital campaign. I will preach on the campaign next Sunday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>. The following Sunday, October 29<sup>th</sup>, is parish Commitment Sunday. We can make our goal. We can realize our dreams. Thank you!


