<u> HOLV WEEK 2017:</u>

+ NEXT SUNDAY, APRIL 9 is Passion (Palm) Sunday. Our weekend schedule will be our usual Saturday at 5:00 pm and Sunday at 9:00 & 11:00 am. However, again this year, if you participate in the Saturday evening Mass, you are invited to gather at the Tallmadge Circle first at 4:45 pm for the Blessing of Palms, and then a Procession from the Circle to the Church, where we will continue with the 5:00 Mass. For any unable to participate in the Procession, BLESSED PALMS will be available for you at the end of Mass. (In case of inclement weather, we hopefully will gather in Finnerty Hall instead.) For the Sunday Masses, please come early, to receive your palms and join in the opening prayers, blessing of palms, and procession into Church.

- † ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR CONFESSION will be offered on *Tuesday*, *April 11*, *from 10:00-11:00 am*; and *Wednesday*, *April 12*, *from 5:00-6:00 pm*. There will be NO confessions on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, or Holy Saturday.
- † **CHRISM MASS** at the Cathedral of St John the Evangelist (Cleveland) *Tuesday, April 11 at 7:00 pm.* This celebration is open to the public and includes a gathering of the bishops, priests, deacons and faithful from around the Diocese, as the oils used in the sacramental ministry of the parishes are blessed and consecrated.
- + **WEDNESDAY**, *APRIL 12* these oils will be presented to our community at the 6:30 pm Mass. There are <u>no</u> Stations of the Cross this evening.
- + HOLY THURSDAY APRIL 13: Join us for Morning Prayer at 8:30 am and then later, for the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 pm. While there is no monetary collection that evening, please consider bringing food for those in need as a sign of our service and love for others. Following this Mass, the Blessed Sacrament will be moved to the Reposition Chapel (TBD) where all may come to keep watch of the Blessed Sacrament in Prayer. Consider coming anytime between 8:15 and 9:45 pm. This time of prayerful watch will conclude at 9:45 PM with Night Prayer.

On this night we will also receive into the Church our 4 candidates – Jim Courim, Kelsie Kline, Barbara Nichols, and Cliff Weidrick, who will be confirmed and receive communion for the first time.
