Reading: Matthew 14:22-33

Adults: Jesus calls us all to have courage and come out of our boats; to walk where Jesus wants us to go. Listen carefully to the Lord. Where is He calling you to go? In prayer, ask for what you need to take that step.

Children: In todays' Gospel, Peter gets out of the boat despite the storm? He trusts Jesus enough to get out of the boat when no one else would. Do you find it difficult to trust Jesus? Do you believe He will reach out His hand and save you when you feel like you're drowning?
