OLV MISSION APPEAL - AUG 11 & 12: Mark Curnutte of *Hands Together* will be with us at OLV next weekend. The Catholic mission



group *Hands Together* has operated in Port-au-Prince and Gonaives, Haiti, for three decades. A four-star rated charity, *Hands Together* invests a third of its resources in Catholic education and adult literacy. Haiti has a threadbare public education system that is reserved primarily for the children of

the country's ruling elite. We serve the poorest of the poor and provide meals to several thousand students and elderly people each day.

Drinking contaminated water is one of the leading causes of death in Haiti, and we have operated two well-digging rigs on flatbed trucks for many years, digging hundreds of clean-water wells that are used for drinking, cooking, cleaning, and irrigation. The acute nature of poverty in Haiti – it is the most impoverished country in the Western Hemisphere – has led to widespread deforestation. We are currently teaching ecology in our schools involving our students in a massive tree-planting project. We operate four medical clinics and employ 42 Haitian medical personnel, including three doctors. We try to meet as many needs as possible: providing money for funerals, medicine, housing.
