will go toward your 2017 donations. Donations received via the Collection Basket on Monday 1/1/18, will go toward your 2018 donations. It will not matter if your Monday donation check is dated for Sunday, Dec 31, 2017 – if we receive it on Monday, Jan 1, it will go

toward 2018. Also, if the **postmark on a mailed-in contribution is** 12/31/17 or before, it will be recorded as a 2017 contribution. If it is **postmarked in 2018**, it will be recorded as a 2018 contribution; again, no matter if the check is dated for December 2017. The date of the **postmark is the most important**, not the date on the check, again, per the IRS. For Faith Direct users, they will be accepting one-time gifts until *Dec 22 at 3pm*, and live one-time credit card gifts until *midnight on Dec 31* if you'd like to do an end-of-year contribution.
