PARISH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS for Catholic School Students for the 2016-2017 academic year are now available at the Parish Office for those wishing to apply for such assistance. If you are registering your child in a Catholic School for the 2016-2017 academic year, you may pick up an application to complete and return to the Parish Offices, attention: Fr. Mike. BE AWARE THAT YOU MAY BE ELLIGIBLE FOR "DIOCESAN TUITION ASSISTANCE". If the school you have chosen uses Private School Aid Service (PSAS), obtain an application from the school (this is separate from the application used for requesting Financial Assistance from Our Lady of Victory), complete the form, and mail to Private School Aid Service by the prescribed deadline (for High Schools or Elementary Schools, both have separate deadlines). The "Parish Code" for Our Lady of Victory is 4508 (this is different from the "School Code"; you will need both on the application). The results of the application are then sent to the Diocese for consideration of "need" among all the needs of applicants in determining awards. The deadline for submitting application requests to Our Lady of Victory is Monday, April 25th. As always, a completed application (whether for OLV or PSAS) does not guarantee financial assistance will be granted, but is necessary for consideration. Applicants (whether for OLV or PSAS) will be notified of awards granted/not granted sometime after the middle of June. Diocesan Tuition Assistance may be available, based on financial need, for most Catholic Elementary and High Schools in the Diocese. Parish Assistance may be available for Kindergarten through 8th Grade. Education Endowment Fund Scholarships are from 1st through 12th Grades.

THE 2016 ANNUAL CATHOLIC CHARITIES IN-PEW APPEAL takes place next-weekend (February 6/7) at all of the weekend Masses. THANK YOU for your past generosity! You have been outstanding in your care for the needy (a Corporal Work of Mercy!), always exceeding our parish goal, with 2015 being no different. Our 2016 Goal is \$65,381. While this is an increase over last year, the amount pledged for 2015 was \$68,822, so, I am hope-filled that the goal will be met, perhaps even exceeded. The In-Pew Appeal is for all who have not yet responded to their mail campaign. Barring any unforeseen situations (for example: terrible weather as has been the case the past couple of years), and our reaching our campaign goal, next weekend's appeal will not be repeated, so, again, we urge you to respond either to the mail campaign or the In-Pew Appeal next weekend. Celebrating Notes

THE FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD will be celebrated on *Tuesday, Feb 2*. This Feast, occurring 40 days after Christmas, marks the time when Mary and Joseph presented Jesus in the Temple. Customarily, the celebration includes the blessing of candles for the faithful to use in their homes, as well as candles used in Church. This will take place at the 8:30 AM Mass that day. **The Feast of St Blaise** follows on *Wednesday, Feb 3*. For many centuries the Church has offered a "Blessing of St Blaise", which has become a blessing of throats on his Feast Day (using candles blessed on The Presentation of the Lord). There will be two opportunities for those wishing to obtain this blessing: *Wednesday, Feb 3 at 8:30 am Mass, or at Evening Prayer at 7pm*.
