PARISH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS for Catholic School Students for the 2017-2018 academic year are available at the Parish Office for those wishing to apply, or ON-LINE AT THE PARISH WEBSITE www.ourladyofvictory.net. BE AWARE THAT YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR DIOCESAN TUITION ASSISTANCE. A Private School Aid Service (PSAS) Application may be obtained from the school (this is separate from the application used for Financial Assistance from Our Lady of Victory). Complete the form, and mail to Private School Aid Service by the prescribed deadline (for High Schools or Elementary Schools, both have separate deadlines). The "Parish Code" for Our Lady of Victory is 4508 (this is different from the "School Code"; you will need both on the application). The results of the application are then sent to the Diocese for consideration of "need" among all the needs of applicants in determining awards. The deadline for submitting application requests to Our Lady of Victory is Monday, April 3rd. As always, a completed application (whether for OLV or PSAS) does not guarantee financial assistance, but is necessary for consideration. Applicants for OLV will be notified of awards granted/not granted sometime after the middle of June. Diocesan Tuition Assistance may be available, based on financial need, for most Catholic Elementary and High Schools in the Diocese. Parish Assistance from OLV may be available for K-8th Grade. Education Endowment Fund Scholarships are from 1st-12th Grades.

Celebrating Notes

OUT OF PASTORAL SOLICITUDE, Bishop Daniel Thomas has formally dispensed the faithful of the Diocese of Cleveland from the obligation to abstain from meat on St Patrick's Day, which will be observed on Friday, Mar 17. Those who choose to partake of meat on that day are encouraged to undertake another penance in the form of a corporal or spiritual work of mercy. In this way, a faithful Catholic still keeps the penitential spirit of a Friday in Lent, and unites oneself more closely with the suffering Christ and His Church.

GIVE ALMS FOR THE NEEDY:

1) FINANCIAL SUPPORT: Each week, through Palm Sunday, as we leave church, we invite you to contribute a monetary donation in the alms baskets (*Make checks payable to Our Lady of Victory*). This year the alms will go to Blessed Trinity Food Pantry.

2) FOOD: On *Mar 4/5*, we invite all to participate in our annual Food for the Hungry by placing non-perishable items near the baptismal font in the Sanctuary. All of these items will be given to Blessed Trinity Food Pantry, for the needy in North Hill. *All other weeks through Palm Sunday*, we invite you to continue your food donations, placing them in the front vestibule of the Church. Tallmadge Good Neighbors will be the recipient of these donations, to help meet the needs in Tallmadge.

LENTEN RESOURCES: Pick up your Lenten resources after any weekend Mass until they're gone. **A Free-will offering will be accepted.** Every week, be sure to try "Take Five for Faith", the FREE leaflets available in the plastic holders at the entrances; and also enjoy the inserts to be included in each week's bulletin during Lent. Resources for Holy

Week, Triduum, and Easter (The "Little White Book") will be available a little closer to Easter.

WEDNESDAY LENTEN PRAYERS: During Lent, we move our Wednesday morning Mass to 6:30 pm, to allow more people to attend, followed by Stations of the Cross at 7:00 pm, except Wed, Mar 15. (More about that in next week's bulletin.) There will be no Mass or Stations of the Cross on Fridays during Lent at OLV.

CONGRATULATIONS TO Barbara Sutherland, a junior at Our Lady of the Elms High School, who earned her Girl Scout Gold Award earlier this month, which is the highest award in Girl Scouting! Only about 5% of eligible Girl Scouts complete service projects to earn this award.
