### Question of the Week

Reading: John 14:1-12

Adults: In today's Gospel, as Jesus prepares His disciples for His departure, He sees their concerns and tries to reassure them, and us. The words are meant to give comfort: do not be afraid, have faith, I prepare a place, and He will "come back and take you to myself". Read and reflect on this passage, allowing yourself to hear this passage as spoken to you personally. Share your reflections with someone else.

Today, Jesus tells us that He is the Way, the Truth, Children: and the Life. He is telling us that He wants us to be with Him, the Father, and the Holy Spirit in Heaven! But in order to do that, we must follow Him. Do you follow Jesus? Do you invite Him into your heart? What does your relationship with Jesus look like today?
