**Question of the Week**

Gospel: Luke 15:1-32

Adults: In the Gospel, there is a collection of stories about God's mercy and compassion. On the 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary of 9/11, we are called to be as merciful and compassionate as our Father. What is the most profound compassion and mercy I have ever felt for another? What is the most profound compassion and mercy I have experienced from another?

Children: No one is perfect. It's easy to forget that when someone does something to make us angry, and easy to remember when we make mistakes! This is what mercy is all about. We are merciful to others when they hurt us, and we hope for mercy when we hurt others. Today's Gospel shows us how much God loves us, and wants to shower His mercy on us. Is there someone in your life you need to forgive? Someone who you need to show mercy to? Is there someone who you need to ask forgiveness from? Try to do those things this week.
