ASSISTANCE FOR THE VICTIMS OF HURRICANE IRMA - The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have asked that an emergency collection for those impacted by Hurricane Irma take place the weekend of Sept 30-Oct 1. As Bishop Perez wrote in his letter to the parishes, "I am aware that this call comes on the heels of the emergency collection for Hurricane Harvey. Hurricane Irma has been devastating... in the Caribbean, especially the Diocese of St Thomas in the Virgin Islands and the southern U.S. . . . The Church in these regions is a longstanding provider of aid, and now is in need of tremendous assistance itself. So many of the Church's structures have been damaged and their resources depleted... These funds will be used in the affected areas to support humanitarian aid, assistance with long-term efforts to restore communities, and for the pastoral reconstruction needs of the Church in the U.S. and Caribbean."
