#### January-March 2017 — Quarterly Report

Thank you and God bless you for your continued support to those in need from our parish family. Your generosity allows us to continue to serve the most needy and to be a living example of Mercy.

With your gifts we were able to assist, on a monthly basis, 29 families with food and financial aid. During the past quarter our food pantry has been well stocked with continuous donations of food from parishioners and other residents (464 bags). We distributed **500 bags of food** to families in need. We assisted families with financial help (\$6,440.00), and over \$1,815.00 in gift cards for perishable food, clothing, and other personal needs. Please note:

- In February students from St. Joseph High School donated 217 bags of food.
- Social Concerns Ministry also supported the *God's* Special People's luncheon in February.
- Thank you to Holy Savior Academy's Brownie Troop 65402 for over 40 bags of food.
- Reimbursements from Catholic Charities: \$1500.00. (Part of your donations to the Bishop's Annual Appeal and Catholic Charities does come back to the parish)



### THIS IS OUR FAITH



As Catholics we believe Jesus rose from the dead. But if that's all that happened, Christianity would have ended 2,000 years ago in Jerusalem. The power of Jesus's death and resurrection lies not in the empty tomb, but in the changed lives of the Apostles! The Apostles had journeyed with Jesus for 3 years. They had left their jobs, families and friends to follow Him throughout all of Palestine; they had gone out two-by-two proclaiming the Kingdom

of God and performing miracles in His name. Yet they ran away when the authorities came to arrest Jesus.

The Resurrection of Jesus and His subsequent appearances to the apostles and other disciples changed these men and women



who were so close to Jesus. It changed them from cowards who ran away from Jesus on Holy Thursday and went into hiding, to people who openly began to speak and teach about Jesus, perform miracles in His name and ultimately to confront the power of the Jews and the entire Roman Empire. The Resurrection of Jesus issues the same call to each of us today. Just as the men and women who surrounded Jesus 2,000 years ago, we are called to live a changed life.

Today, we here at Sacred Heart begin our month-long call to Discipleship and Stewardship. The Bishops of the United States tell us "once one chooses to be a disciple of Jesus Christ, Stewardship is no longer an option." So, Stewardship is a way of life for each of us!

But what is Stewardship? What does it mean? Lisa Rohr of McKenna Stewardship Ministries says, "In brief I think we can define that a Christian steward is a disciple who lives in gratitude by recognizing and embracing God's gifts and sharing them in

When I stand before God at the end of my life, I would hope that I would not have a single bit of talent left, and could say, "I used everything You gave me." love of God and of one's neighbor." Throughout Holy Scripture there are constant reminders that we are called to be stewards of all of God's gifts....our time and talents, our communities, the earth we live on with its natural resources, our relationships with family and others, and even our financial resources. We must truly recognize that everything belongs to God and we are stewards or caretakers who are expected to use the gifts in

service to one another, in gratitude to God. Simply put, it is based on the biblical view of God as Creator and we are His servants. We are accountable to God for the use of our gifts of time, talent, and treasure that He gives us during our life on earth. Stewardship provides us with the foundation for a deepened faith for all of us and our parish.


## STEWARDSHIP is LOVE in action.
