

An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. Please note that we can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.

THIS IS OUR FAITH

"Be Not Afraid"

In the northern United States, free from light pollution, the night sky is crystal clear. In a large city, we perceive these stars to be absent because we cannot see them. But the stars are always present and shining brightly despite our inability to see them. In this Sunday's Gospel, we meditate on the mystery of God who the disciples believe is absent in the midst of the storm. Jesus, in stepping back from His disciples, shows that God sometimes seems to mysteriously hide. Scripture speaks often of this experience:

"How long, oh Lord? Will You forget me forever? How long will You hide Your face from me?" (Psalm 13:1)"Do not hide your face from your servant; answer me quickly, for I am in trouble." (Psalm 69:17)" "Lord," Martha said to Jesus, "if you had been here, my brother would not have died." (John 11:21)Jesus himself, said on the cross, "my God, my God, why have you abandoned me?" (Matthew 27:46)

God, in his mysterious plan of salvation, appears to be absent from the lives of His people. In times of tragedy, great pain, or suffering, people often ask, "Where was God?" But we must remember the wisdom of today's Gospel – that when the waves are crashing around the boat, and the winds of the storm howling, and the disciples full of anxiety, Jesus is on the mountain in loving communion with God the Father.

Jesus walks across the water toward the disciples, calming the storm and says to them (and us), "Fear not, it is I. Be not afraid." In other words, though we may be in frightening or trying situations, His power is always greater. Notice here that He does



not promise there will be no "storms" in life. But He shows us by word and action that He has power over all of them. "Fear not, is I. Be not afraid!"

There are times in our life too that we expect Jesus to be present to us in a particular way. Often it is we, through the darkness of our

intellect, pride, or stubbornness who fail to recognize that Jesus is present and working in ways we may not perceive or understand. "This is a fundamental choice we face as Christians: in times of adversity, do I turn inward in fear? Or do I choose authentic communion with God the Father?

What are the storms and winds occurring in my life today? Do I trust that Jesus, though He may seem absent at times, is truly loving me in these moments?

Jesus offers us the gift of peace, for He is the Prince of Peace. Although at times we perceive Him to be absent or distant, He is always present and interceding for us before God the Father. May we constantly turn to Him in prayer, particularly during the trials and tribulations of our own lives.



Next weekend we welcome Rev. Peter Mandina of the Diocese of Machakos, Kenya who will speak on behalf of his people. The Diocese of Machakos is one of the largest in Kenya with 76



parishes and over 1,000 outstations. Total population is about 3.3 million of which about 1.6 million are baptized Catholics. The Diocese lies in a semi -arid area where the annual rainfall is low and unreliable. Drought, famine & poverty are challenges faced by much of the population, since they depend on agriculture

for their livelihood. The effects of malnutrition and HIV/AIDS is the cause of death for many young children.

The Catholic church in Kenya has a unique role in the lives of its citizens. Improving the lives of the people is usually accomplished through the efforts of the church rather than of the government. Thanks in large part to the prayers and support of Catholics in the United States, the Church in Machakos is growing and is making a positive difference in the lives of the people including:

- Operating 2 hospitals and over 20 clinics/dispensaries.
- Drilling of wells to provide clean water.
- · Establishing immunization programs.


