





**SPONSOR LETTERS -** Canon (Church) Law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active. Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. We can only write Letters of Eligibility for parishioners who meet these criteria.

BAPTISM/SPONSORSHIP CLASS - Parents and godparents are required to attend one session before the child's baptism date can be confirmed. Sessions are held on the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:00PM in the Parish Center - 3rd floor. (Adults only - please, no infants or children.) Registration is required. ## THIS IS OUR FAITH

#### NO MORE CCD? continued

"If it ain't broke, don't fix it." Well, is the old CCD (Confraternity of Christian Doctrine) model working? According to Sherry Weddell, author of "Forming Intentional Disciples", the CCD Model was designed in the 17th century to counter the Protestant Reformation.

"The assumption was that a carefully nurtured religious identify acquired in childhood would endure throughout life. The Jesuit motto said it all "Give me a child until he is 7, and I will give you the man." The author continues, "But the evidence suggests that what worked in the 17th century does not work in the 21st. Pew researchers found that attending CCD, youth groups, and even Catholic high schools made little or no difference to whether or not an American Catholic teen ended up staying Catholic, becoming Protestant, or leaving to become "unaffiliated".

Here are some of the current statistics regarding Catholicism in America<sup>2:</sup>

- Only 30% of Americans raised Catholic are still practicing:
   i.e., attend Mass at least once a month
- ♦ 38% identify as Catholic, but seldom or never attend Mass
- ♦ The final 32% no longer consider themselves Catholic

It has long been an assumption that although Catholic teens vanish after Confirmation they come back for marriage and raising their families. However the number of Catholic marriages have fallen 60% between 1972 and 2010, although the Catholic population has increased by 17 million. Also of those attending Sunday Mass, the vast majority are over 65 years old, see chart below<sup>3:</sup>

Generations		Attending Sunday Mass
Builders	Age 65+	45%
Boomers	Age 47-64	20%
Gen X	Age 26-49	13%
Millennials	Age 18-25	10%

It is obvious that we are not transferring the Faith to future generations as well as we had done in the past. However we also have to ask, what kind of faith are we transferring to those who remain.

Weddell, states that the "bedrock foundation" at the heart of Catholicism is belief in a personal God who loves us. She goes on to report statistics from the Pew Research Group that only 48 percent of Catholics were absolutely certain that the God they believed in was a God with whom they could have a personal relationship. So the person you are sitting next to at Mass may be there with an entirely different belief in God then the one held by Catholic teaching.<sup>4</sup>

So, it's broke and we've got to fix it! What originally worked in passing the Faith from generation to generation is not working now. Moreover, the ability to pass the Faith on has also been affected by dramatic changes in culture and society over the last 50 years which have contributed to the breakdown of common values.

Next week we will review how *Whole Community Catechesis* is designed to counter some of these factors which have contributed to the decline in faith transmission to new generations.

SUSTAINABILITY TIP — Reduce Your Home Energy
