Dear Friends in Christ,

Praised be Jesus Christ! We did it! By combining our talents, energy, resources and especially our prayers, we exceeded the 2017 Bishop's Annual Appeal goal by over one million dollars. As of July 17, pledges have

reached \$8,008,000 from more than 27,000 families. This was accomplished in a shorter time period and with less expenses within the new structure of the appeal. I am most grateful for the enthusiastic support of our clergy, lay leaders and all of our generous parishioners whose contributions made our success possible. The money donated this year is the highest amount the diocese has ever raised for our annual appeal and we had the highest number of donors in many years, too.

Meeting our financial target allows us to continue the vital ministries that serve thousands of people each day throughout Middlesex, Somerset, Hunterdon and Warren counties. In addition to continuing and enhancing our efforts in evangelization, youth-related ministries and pastoral life, the successful outcome of the appeal will assist our seminarians in receiving the education needed to prepare them to serve as shepherds of our parishes in the future and will allow our hospital chaplains to continue consoling and comforting patients and family members in the 17 hospitals and healthcare facilities within our diocesan boundaries. With \$1.7 million dollars allocated to our Catholic Charities, we will be able to provide for the most poor and vulnerable among us.

Money raised over our goal will allow us to fund needed ministries that have been putting our diocese into deficit spending in recent years; so these above-goal funds will enable us to work at cutting that diocesan deficit we have been experiencing. Of course, we have been trimming our budget wherever possible too. I am truly grateful for your generosity, as are those who benefit each day from these needed ministries and outreach.

As a bonus, many of our parishes have taken advantage of the parish rebate incentive to raise additional funds for local needs. A new church roof, updated sound system, added programs for youth and a refurbished Mary Garden are just a few of the parish -based projects made possible through this appeal. Parish rebates are 50 percent of the amount collected over goal.

Thank you, again, for your overwhelming response. I am particularly grateful to our pastors and the parish coordinators of the appeal who worked so hard to ensure our success. Together, we are Ambassadors for Christ helping to make our world and our diocese a better place. God bless you and be assured you have my heartfelt gratitude and prayers.

Thank you and God bless you for your continued support to those in need from our parish family. The generous sharing of your gifts allows us to continue to serve those in need and to be a living example of Mercy. Because of you, we were able to assist, on a monthly basis, 26 families with food and financial assistance. During the past quarter our food pantry has been well stocked from continuous donations of food by parishioners and other SP residents (296 bags). We distributed 495 bags of food to families in need. We also assisted families with financial help (\$7,038.00), and over \$1,735.00 in gift cards for perishable food, clothing, and other personal needs.

THANK YOU...Children from the Religious Education Summer Program from grades two, four, and eight, along with their teachers who visited our food pantry to learn about the workings of our ministry. Many questions were asked and the children seemed quite enthusiastic and eager to learn about helping others. On Friday, 7/21 we received over 80 bags of food and wish to thank the children, their parents, and teachers for a very successful food drive and for their interest in our food pantry.

SPONSOR LETTERS - Canon (Church) Law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. Please note that we can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.



THIS IS OUR FAITH

The Transfiguration

"We are being called into an ongoing transformation in Jesus Christ, beginning right now. Does it seem somewhat esoteric or perhaps a bit too theological? On this feast day we are invited to consider whether the truth it reveals is being embraced and experienced in our own daily lives. It is not meant only for theologians to speculate over, or for mystics alone to encounter. We are all invited into the experience. The path up that mountain proceeds through prayer and encounter. On that Mountain, Jesus revealed before mortal eyes the Transcendent Truth of who He is - and who Peter, James and John - and each one of us - will become in Him. They were invited to exercise their freedom and embrace the path that He had prepared. So are we, right now.

The feast we celebrate this day is a very ancient one. We are invited, by reflecting on this significant event in the life and ministry of Jesus Christ, to focus on the *end* of the Christian life. *End* in the philosophical and theological sense means purpose or goal. The Transfiguration helps to explain the very meaning and purpose of life!



We will all be transfigured, as the Lord Himself was transfigured, when our redemption is complete in the Resurrection of the Body. Then, we will live in the new heaven and new earth, in a transformed cosmos! This reality is meant to affect the way we live our lives beginning right now. However, many Christians have never even considered it. Many do not even know it is the teaching of the Gospel and the teaching of the Church.

This event on the Mountain was meant to strengthen the faith of these three disciples. They were about to witness the events that would lead their Lord and Master along what would appear to be an ignominious path, up Golgotha's lonely hill, to be crucified, a fate reserved for common criminals.

Their own faith would be shaken, tested and tried. The Lord wanted to encourage them - and He wants to encourage us.

As the apostles lived their lives no longer for themselves but for Him, they began to undergo their own trials and walked the way to their own transfiguration." As we live our life of joys and trials, hopes and fears, we are all called to follow Jesus by saying "Yes" to the Father's will in our own lives, and by our "Yes" reaching our own promised Transfiguration.
