SPONSOR LETTERS - Canon (Church) Law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. We can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.

BAPTISM/SPONSORSHIP CLASS - Parents and godparents are required to attend one session before the child's baptism date can be confirmed. Sessions are held on the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:00PM in the Parish Center - 3rd floor. (Adults only - please, no infants or children.) Registration is required. THIS IS OUR FAITH

No More CCD!?

Is it true that CCD is no more here at Sacred Heart? The simple answer is Yes. The traditional CCD (Confraternity of Christian Doctrine) program, where most children have gone to a classroom and have been educated in the Faith, is gone!

But don't children need to learn about God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and the Church; who is going to teach them? Yes, children do need to learn about God, Jesus, Church, but so do we all need to learn about these. Although CCD is gone - as you knew it, learning must continue for all of us.

And so we are instituting Whole Community Catechesis (WCC) here at Sacred Heart. In Whole Community Catechesis, children will learn about God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, the Church, and receive the training for their sacraments, but will do it in the context of their whole family ... learning together about these things. With Whole Community Catechesis the whole family will learn and grow together. In addition the whole parish family will also be invited to join in the process of learning about Jesus and as they feel drawn to participate, to grow in the Faith.

Some of you may be saying, as we read this, why do I have to come and learn about Jesus, God, and the Church? I know enough! Besides, I am already too busy with my family, and work, the kids' activities, the house, my job, taking care of my parents, etc., etc., I am too busy now, and this is just another obligation this danged church is putting on me. If you are feeling this way, it might help to ask yourself the question ... why am I here, why am I living on this earth?

As Christians, we have a ready answer to this question through our faith in Jesus Christ. We may not think of it often, and the world's answer to this question is truly going to be different. Our answer is "Man is created to praise, reverence and serve God and by this means to save his soul." And how do we praise, reverence, and serve God? That is the purpose of our Church ... to help us learn how to praise, reverence, and serve God. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus gives the Great Commission:

"16 The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. **17** When they saw Him, they worshiped, but they doubted. **18** Then Jesus approached and said to them, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. **19** Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations ..."

This is the most important function of the Church, **Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations!!** But what is a disciple? One definition is: *a disciple is someone who has a vibrant and life transforming relationship with Jesus Christ.*

So let's ask ourselves this question — "Do I have a vibrant and life transforming relationship with Jesus Christ? Is your answer Yes, or are we like the seeds in the Parable of the Sower:

"The seed sown on the path is the one who hears the word of the kingdom without understanding it, and the evil one comes and steals away what was sown in his heart. **20** The seed sown on rocky ground is the one who hears the word and receives it at once with joy. **21** But he has no root and lasts only for a time. When some tribulation or persecution comes because of the word, he immediately falls away. **22** The seed sown among thorns is the one who hears the word, but then worldly anxiety and the lure of riches choke the word and it bears no fruit. **23** But the seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold." — *Matthew 13:19-23* ▶▶▶
