
bins located in the entrances of the church.

BAPTISM/SPONSORSHIP CLASS - Parents and godparents are required to attend one session before the child's baptism date can be confirmed. Sessions are held on **the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:00PM** in the Parish Center - 3rd floor. (Adults only - please, no infants or children.) Registration is required. SPONSOR LETTERS - Canon (Church) Law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. Please note that we can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.

AED IN CHURCH - An Automated External Defibrillator

(AED) is a portable electronic device that automatically diagnoses the life-threatening cardiac arrhythmias of ventricular fibrillation and ventricular tachycardia in a patient, and is able to treat them through defibrillation allowing the heart to reestablish an effective rhythm. We have purchased & installed an AED in church to assist in emergency medical situations. The AED is door-mounted next to the St. Joseph statue at the front of the church.

THIS IS OUR FAITH

"Leave your gift at the altar ... and first be reconciled with your brother"

GAUDETE SUNDAY -- "Let us rejoice!" We are halfway through the preparation time for Christmas. The Church gives us *Gaudete Sunday* as a pause in this waiting period leading to Christmas; a time of prayer, penance and almsgiving for Christmas. The Church knows us only too well as does God. There must always be "a light at the end of the tunnel" to enable us to maintain hope and to keep going.

The readings for this third Sunday of Advent focus on the glory of the coming Kingdom of God. In this kingdom, nature will be freed from all its struggles. *"The desert and dry land will exult; the steppe will rejoice and bloom... feeble hands will be strengthened... weak knees made firm... frightened hearts will be made strong."* In the Gospel, Jesus adds *"Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them."*

Jesus' name means "God saves"! But God does not save us by Himself, no, He <u>requires</u> our participation — not by our performing magnificent acts of courage, boldness, bravery, endurance, suffering. Not by any of these outstanding acts, but in our repeating His most generous act of forgiveness. In the Lord's Prayer, Jesus tells us how to enter the Kingdom, when He says: *"forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those*

who trespass against us." To be clear and certain, Jesus tells us this same thing numerous times:

Mt 6:14-15 — "If you forgive others their transgressions, your heavenly Father will forgive you. But if you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive your transgressions.



Mt 18:20-22 — "Then Peter approaching asked him, "Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive him? As many as seven times?" Jesus answered, "I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times."

Mk 11:25 — "When you stand to pray, forgive anyone against whom you have a grievance, so that your heavenly Father may in turn forgive you your transgressions."

Mt 5: 23 — "Therefore, if you bring your gift to the altar, and there recall that your brother has anything against you, leave your gift there at the altar, go first and be reconciled with your brother, and then come and offer your gift."

So stop what you are doing right now and make a resolution that before you raise your heart and mind to God in prayer again, before you go to Mass again, before you walk up to receive Jesus, your Savior, and offer yourself to Him, that you will forgive your brother or sister, husband or wife, child, coworker, friend or enemy, church member, political leader, anyone for whom you hold anger in your heart. Remember, in today's second reading, St. James says, *"Do not complain, brothers and sisters, about one another, that you may not be judged. Behold, the Judge is standing before the gates."*


HISTORY OF OUR DIOCESE'S BEGINNINGS
