

**SPONSOR LETTERS** - Canon (Church) Law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. Please note that we can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.

# The Mass

Do you ever wonder why the Church asks that we go to Mass? Well, the simple reason is, Jesus directly told us to do so in order to share His love and His life with us. But before we get to the simple, direct command of Jesus, let's review what led up to it.

Imagine you are planning the festivities for a major holiday for your family and friends, all those you love. You want everything to be just right, all the special things that you usually do at this holiday. But you know one additional thing this year, you know– this is the last time you will see all these people, you have learned that you are going to die and this is your last gathering with those you love.

This is exactly the situation in which Jesus found Himself when He was at His last Passover Seder with the Apostles, his "Last Supper". The Apostles were the men whom He had trained, formed and spent every waking moment with for the last three years, the men on whom he was



depending to carry His message to the "ends of the earth" Because of this Jesus wants to make this a very memorable Seder. Jesus wants to say something special to the Apostles and to give them something special, His very self.

"The origins of the Eucharist (The Mass) are found in the Last Supper that Jesus shared with His Apostles. "In order to leave them a pledge of this (His love), in order never to depart from His own and to make them sharers in his Passover (his sacrifice), He instituted the Eucharist as the memorial of His death and Resurrection and commanded His Apostles to celebrate it until His return..."

Also in 1 Corinthians. St. Paul says that he too received these commands directly from Jesus:

"For I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you that the Lord Jesus, on the night He was handed over, took bread, and, after He had given thanks, broke it and said, "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." (1 Cor. 11:23-26")

— U.S. Catholic Catechism for Adults - Chap 17

This is why the Church asks and requires us to attend Mass at least weekly on Sunday, which is the commemoration of the day that Jesus rose from the dead - because Jesus commanded us to do this in remembrance of Him!

# PAPAL QUOTE AND CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING

**THEME 6: Care for God's Creation:** We show our respect for the Creator by our *stewardship of creation*. Care for the earth is not just an Earth Day slogan, it is a requirement of our faith. We are called to protect people and the planet, living our faith in relationship with all of God's creation. This environmental challenge has fundamental moral and ethical dimensions that cannot be ignored.

"These problems are closely linked to a throwaway culture which affects the excluded just as it quickly reduces things to rubbish. To cite one example, most of the paper we produce is thrown away and not recycled. It is hard for us to accept that the way natural ecosystems work is exemplary: plants synthesize nutrients which feed herbivores; these in turn become food for carnivores, which produce significant quantities of organic waste which give rise to new generations of plants. But our industrial system, at the end of its cycle of production and consumption, has not developed the capacity to absorb and reuse waste and by -products. We have not yet managed to adopt a circular model of production capable of preserving resources for present and future generations, while limiting as much as possible the use of nonrenewable resources, moderating their consumption, maximizing their efficient use, reusing and recycling them. A serious consideration of this issue would be one way of counteracting the throwaway culture which affects the entire planet, but it must be said that only limited progress has been made in this regard ...
