By now you have received your letter from Bishop Checchio announcing the 2017 Bishop's Annual Appeal. You will be interested to know that Bishop Checchio, after a number of meetings and in consultation with many of the pastors and staff, has made some changes to the Appeal. The first, as you probably already noticed, the Appeal has been moved from the Fall to a Lenten campaign. The active phase has been condensed and the number of solicitation mailings has been reduced. Another significant change is the reintroduction of Parish Rebates. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. Please note that we can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.

### THIS IS OUR FAITH

### The Mass

Last Week, we discussed that Jesus commanded us to celebrate the Eucharist in Remembrance of Him. As we look back in history we find that the Mass is not new. Yes, there have been changes over time, but the essential structure is as it was in the second century. When we attend Mass we are doing what the first Christians did 1900 years ago. Those Christians who were very close to Jesus and the original apostles, in time, place and personal relationship!

How do we know that the structure of the Mass has been the same for the last 1900 years? Read the description from St. Justin Martyr below and compare it to the structure of the Mass as you experience it today. "St. Justin wrote to the pagan emperor Antoninus Pius (138-161) around the year 155, explaining how Christians lived their faith. The parts in bold are added to explain the references.

"On the day we call the day of the sun (Sunday), all who dwell in the city or country gather in the same place. The memoirs of the apostles and the writings of the prophets are read (The Liturgy of the Word at Mass - the readings from the Old and New Testaments) as much as time permits. When the reader has finished, he (the priest) who presides over those gathered admonishes and challenges them to imitate these beautiful things (Homily/Sermon). Then we all rise together and offer prayers (Intercessions) for ourselves and for all others, wherever they may be, so that we may be found righteous by our life and actions, and faithful to the commandments, so as to obtain eternal salvation. When the prayers are concluded we exchange the kiss (Kiss of Peace). Then someone brings bread and a cup of water and wine mixed together to him who presides over the brethren (Presentation of the Gifts). He takes them and



offers praise and glory to the Father of the universe, through the name of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and for a considerable time he gives thanks (in Greek: *eucharistian*) that we have been judged worthy of these gifts (**Prayers of Thanksgiving and** 

Consecration) When he has concluded the prayers and thanksgivings, all present give voice to an acclamation by saying: 'Amen.' (Great Amen) When he who presides has given thanks and the people have responded, those whom we call deacons give to those present the "eucharisted" bread, wine and water (Reception of Holy Communion by those present) and take them to those who are absent." (From the Catechism of the Catholic Church Sec. 1345)

THE 2017 BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL is focused on three Marquee Ministries.

### **#1 THE OFFICE OF VOCATIONS** (Seminarian Formation)

The **Office of Vocations** provides two basic services to the Diocese of Metuchen. First, it takes care of the education and formation of her seminarians, this includes pastoral visits to each of those young men studying for the Diocese of Metuchen every semester. Second, the Office assists young men and women who may be hearing the call to serve within the Diocese and empowers parishes to find candidates that will make good and holy priests, sisters and brothers. This is done mainly by: working both one-on-one with individuals and in groups to discern what God might be calling them to do, developing tools (prayer services, vocation awareness days, class plans, etc.) that can be used in the parish and school to promote vocations, and visiting the parishes to give talks to schools, youth groups and at Holy Mass.

Currently, there are 15 seminarians in priestly formation far the Diocese of Metuchen. A large portion of our seminarians' education is being funded by the Bishop's Annual Appeal, for which they are extremely grateful.
