**SPONSOR LETTERS** - Canon (Church) Law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. We can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.

**BAPTISM/SPONSORSHIP CLASS** - Parents and godparents are required to attend one session before the child's baptism date can be confirmed. Sessions are held on the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:00PM in the Parish Center - 3rd floor. (Adults only - please, no infants or children.) Registration is required. 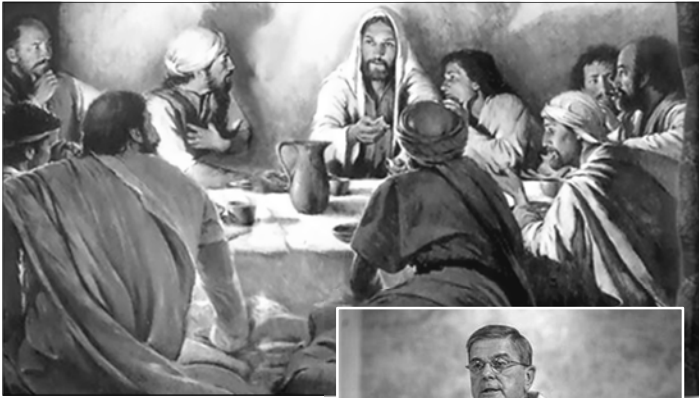
# THIS IS OUR FAITH

## The Mass

Often the question is asked, "As Catholics, why is it our practice to attend Mass every weekend?"

Imagine you are planning the festivities for a major holiday for your family and friends, all those you love. You want everything to be just right, all the special things that you prepare for this holiday. But you know one additional thing about this year that's different than all the years before. This time is the last time you will see these people, you are aware that you are going to die and this will be your last gathering with those you love.

In a truly unique and personal way this is exactly the situation in which Jesus found Himself when He was at the Passover Seder,



His "Last Supper" with the Apostles. These were the men He had instructed, formed and spent every waking moment with for the last three years. Passover is the highpoint of the Hebrew Calendar, the commemoration of God freeing the Jewish people from slavery in Egypt. This would not have been the first Seder that Jesus shared with the Apostles, but He knew it is was going to be His last. This would be a Seder as none before, this Last Supper. He prayed and spoke in a way that would never be forgotten.



"The origins of the Eucharist are found in the Last Supper that Jesus shared with His Apostles. "In order to leave them a pledge of this (His) love, *in order never to depart from His own and to make them sharers in His Passover, He instituted the Eucharist as the memorial of His death and resurrection and commanded His Apostles to celebrate it until His return.* So rich is this mystery that we have a number of terms to illumine its saving grace:

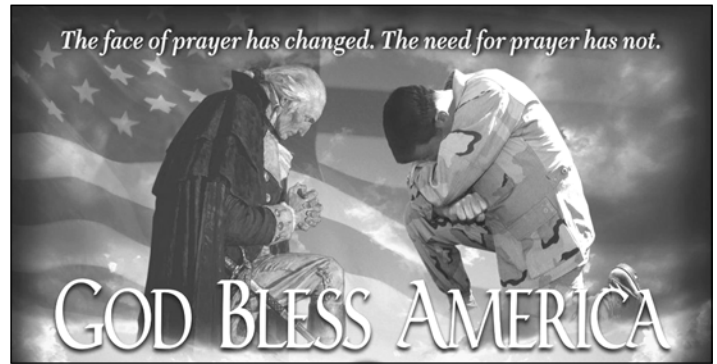
the Breaking of the Bread; the Lord's Supper; the Eucharistic Assembly; the Memorial of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection; the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, the Holy and Divine Liturgy; the Eucharistic Liturgy; Holy Communion; and Holy Mass (cf. CCC, nos. 1328-1332)."

— U.S. Catholic Catechism for Adults - Chapter 17



This is why The Church asks and requires us to attend Mass *at least weekly* on Sunday, which is the commemoration of the day that Jesus rose from the dead.

*Next week, we will discuss the structure of the Mass and our role in the sacrifice and meal that we celebrate in Christ.*



*PAPAL QUOTE AND CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING* — Theme 5: The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers - The **economy must serve people**, not the other way around. Work is more than a way to make a living; it is a form of continuing participation in God's creation. If the dignity of work is to be protected, then the basic rights of workers must be respected--the right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to the organization and joining of unions, to private property, and to economic initiative.

"Work is, as has been said, *an obligation*, that is to say, a *duty, on the part of man*. . . 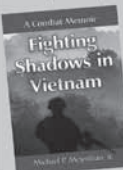
