





**SPONSOR LETTERS** - Canon (Church) Law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. We can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.

**BAPTISM/SPONSORSHIP CLASS** - Parents and godparents are required to attend one session before the child's baptism date can be confirmed. Sessions are held on the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:00PM in the Parish Center - 3rd floor. (Adults only - please, no infants or children.) Registration is required. # THIS IS OUR FAITH

### The Mass

Last Week, we discussed why the Church requires us to attend Mass at least weekly on Sunday. In the Gospel accounts of the Last Supper Jesus Himself "instituted the Eucharist as the memorial of His death and Resurrection and commanded His apostles to celebrate it until his return."

This is corroborated in St. Paul's 1 Corinthians 11: 23-26

"For I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus, on the night he was handed over, took bread, and, after he had given thanks, broke it and said, "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes."

We know that at least since the second century, over 1800 years ago, the Mass (or the Eucharistic Liturgy) has had a structure that is common to all Catholics. The Mass unfolds in two major parts that form a single act of worship.

**FIRST** - there is the Liturgy of the Word, with Scripture Readings, Homily, Profession of Faith, and General Intercessions.

**SECOND** - there is the Liturgy of the Eucharist, with the Presentation of the Bread and Wine, the Eucharistic Prayer, and the Reception of Holy Communion.

The essential elements of Eucharistic celebrations may be summarized in the following four points:

- The Introductory Rites: These begin the celebration of the Mass. This includes the Penitential Rite, the Gloria, and the Opening Prayer.
- 2. The Liturgy of the Word: Over the course of the liturgical year, readings from Scripture, especially the Gospels, provide the heart of this part of the celebration. The readings are followed by a homily from a bishop, priest, or deacon; the Profession of Faith in the recitation of the Creed; and intercessory prayers.
- 3. The Liturgy of the Eucharist, includes:
  - a.) The Preparation of the Gifts (Jesus took bread and wine). The offerings of bread and wine are received by the priest. "They will be offered by the priest in the name of Christ in the Eucharistic sacrifice in which they will become his Body and Blood" (CCC, no. 1350). From the earliest days of the Church, there was also an offering of gifts for the poor and needy. This has become the customary place and time for the parish collection.
  - b.) The Church implores the power of the Holy Spirit to change the bread and wine offered by human hands into Christ's Body and Blood. The priest proclaims Jesus' words at the Last Supper over the bread and wine. "The power of the words and the action of Christ, and the power of the Holy Spirit, make sacramentally present, under the species of bread and wine, Christ's Body and Blood, his sacrifice offered on the Cross for all" (CCC, no. 1353). After the Lord's Prayer, the Lamb of God is sung or said during the breaking of the Body of Christ, or fraction, then we receive the Body and Blood of Christ in Holy Communion. The Communion Rite concludes with a closing prayer.
- 4. The Concluding Rite: Following the prayer after Holy Communion, the priest blesses and dismisses the assembly.


