ENVELOPE USAGE AND YOUR CHURCH OFFERING

— Each year we are all personally presented with situations that initially may appear to be impossible burdens. These often end up becoming opportunities for growth and positive change. In these challenging times, I am most grateful to all of you who support Sacred Heart Parish in every way that you are able. We have never sent a bill to any of our parishioners, nor would we ever. Sacred Heart Church receives bills each day however, that total into the hundreds of thousand of dollars by the end of each year. Your generosity, shared in many ways, is what keeps this parish going spiritually and financially. Every prayer and every contribution make a real difference.



We have over 2,100 registered, active families in our parish. We currently mail out envelopes to approximately 780 households requesting envelopes. The use of the offertory envelope is your personal option. Of those 780 mailed, approximately 450 parishioners use the envelopes for their Church tithe. Not everyone who tithes uses the envelope, and not everyone who receives the envelopes, tithes. Mailing envelopes that are not put to use, for whatever reason, is extremely expensive.

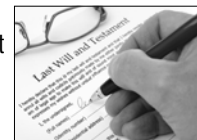
SUMMER ENVELOPES

SPONSOR LETTERS - Canon (Church) Law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage, and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. We can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.

BAPTISM/SPONSORSHIP CLASS - Parents and godparents are required to attend one session before the child's baptism date can be confirmed. Sessions are held on the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:00PM in the Parish Center - 3rd floor. (Adults only - please, no infants or children.) Registration is required. THIS IS OUR FAITH



The following is an excerpt from an article entitled, ***Fanning the Flames of Religious Freedom***, from the *National Catholic Register*, 6/6/16.


BALTIMORE — “Catholics and other Christian faithful live in challenging times that require them to defend their religious liberties while maintaining attitudes of joy, said Baltimore Archbishop William Lori.”

The archbishop heads the *Ad Hoc* Committee for Religious Liberty of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, which, for the last five years, has asked Catholics to recognize the 14 days from June 21 — the vigil of the feast of St. John Fisher and St. Thomas More — to July 4 as the ***Fortnight for Freedom***.”

Archbishop Lori paraphrased Pope Francis in describing religious persecution in the United States and other Western countries as rampant but “polite.” Elsewhere internationally, he explained, “millions of people around the world live with some restrictions on their rights of worship and their freedom of religious expression, and many live under actual physical persecution.”

Culminating on Independence Day, the Fortnight for Freedom is a period of prayer, study, catechesis and public action that emphasizes the Christian and American heritage of liberty. This year’s theme is ***Witnesses to Freedom***” highlighting the Christian example of the Little Sisters of the Poor as well as a number of martyrs who have given their lives for their faith over the last 2,000 years. The U.S. bishops’ conference asks dioceses and parishes to choose a date during the 14 days for special events that “constitute a great national campaign of teaching and witness for religious liberty.”

Here at Sacred Heart Parish we will celebrate the Fortnight in a number of ways. First we will dedicate the Monday evening Holy Hour (6-7PM) prior to the 7PM Mass on June, 27 to this cause. Please try to attend as a family!! Second we will distribute the 14 “Witness to Freedom” bulletin inserts over the next 14 weeks so we can persistently be reminded of the need to protect our religious liberty. These witness sheets can also be found on the Parish Website. Finally, we will also have Movie Afternoons/Nights over the next three months, highlighting some of the films about these martyrs: *Becket*, *A Man for All Seasons* and *For Greater Glory*. 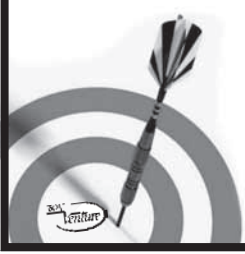
